Methodology

- 846 randomly selected **Malaysian adults aged 21+** were interviewed via telephone for the survey
- Respondents were selected via random stratified sampling method along the lines of state of residence, ethnicity, gender and age
- Survey was carried out between 29 September – 4 October 2009
- Survey margin of error estimated at $\pm 3.4\%$
- Important events during survey period: Padang 7.6 magnitude earthquake, Bagan Pinang By-election Nomination, on-going developments surrounding approaching MCA EGM, developments surrounding approaching UMNO General Assembly

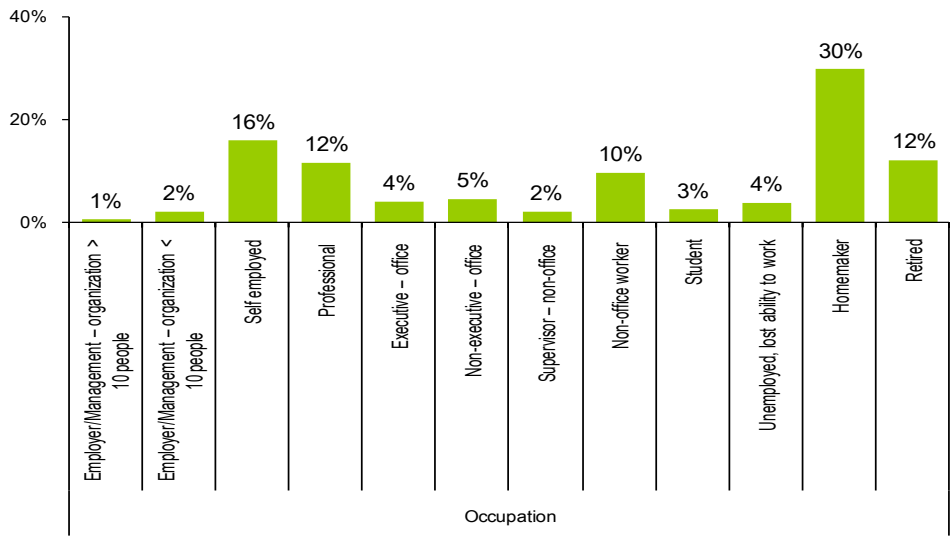

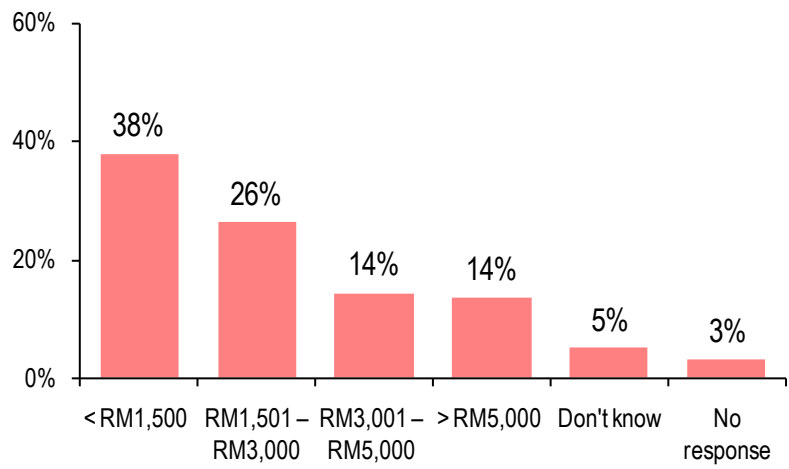

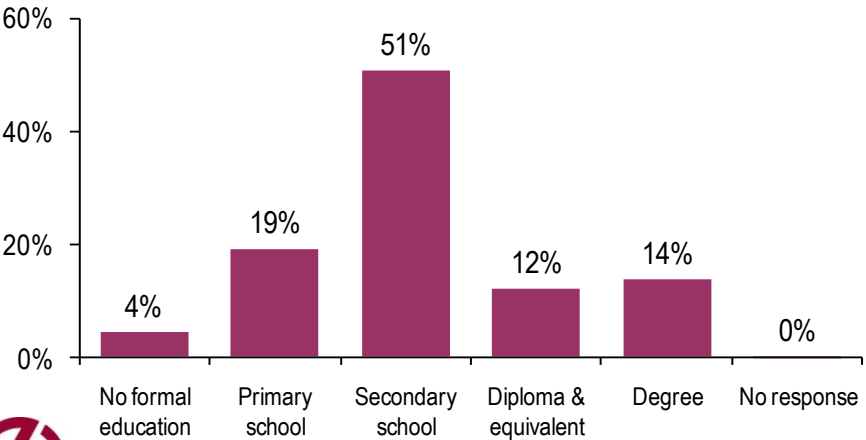
Occupation



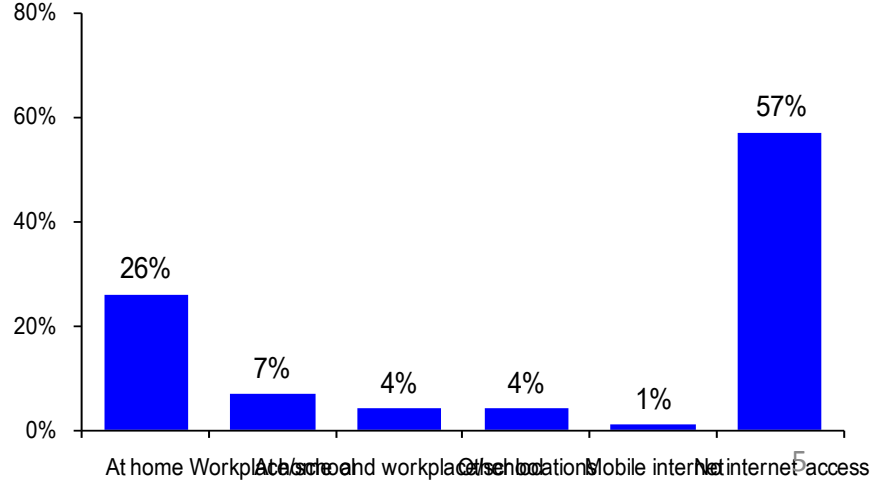
Monthly household income

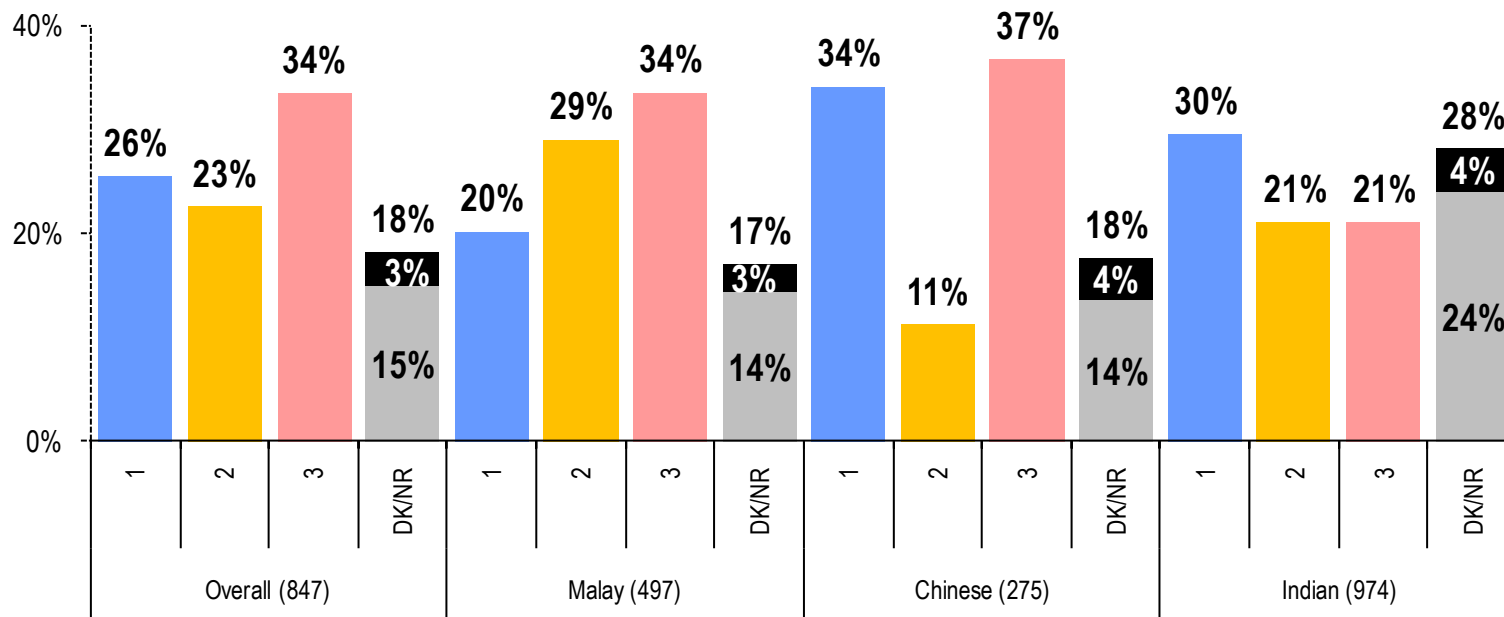

View on BN component parties' reform

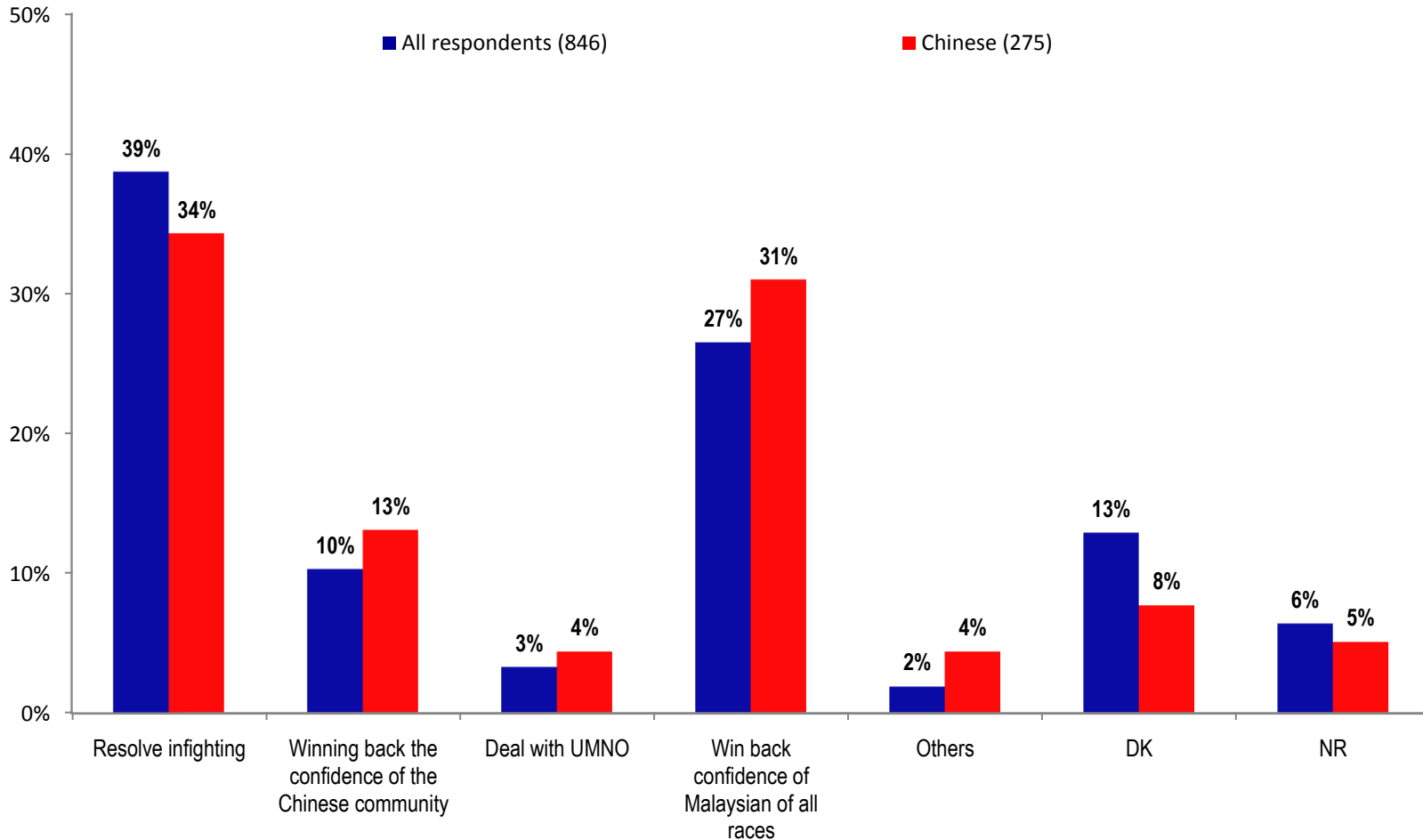
What is your view on reforms with regards to the individual component parties in BN?

- 3 Unless UMNO reforms extensively, changes in other component parties will mean little

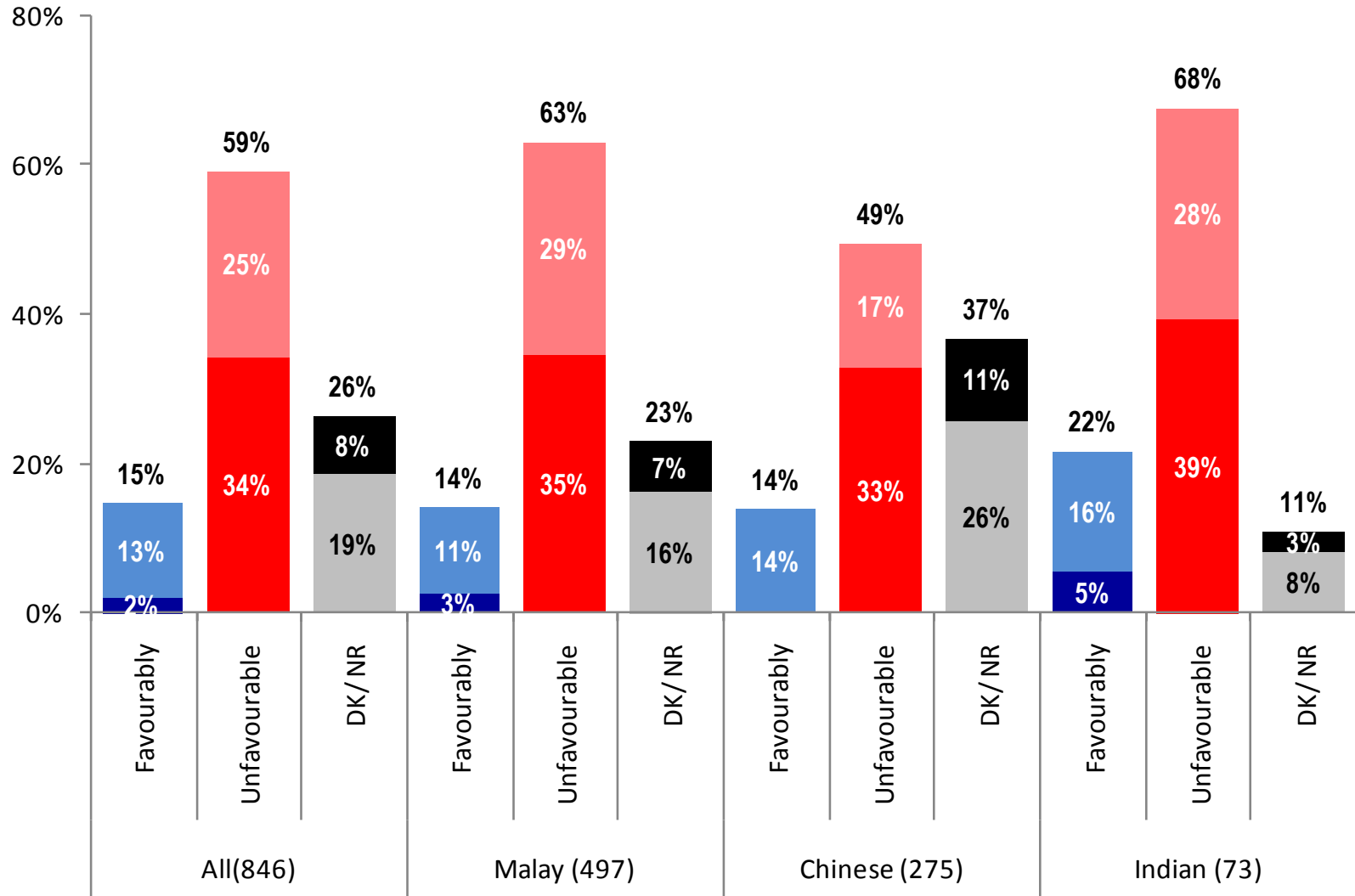
Focus on MCA party reforms

How do you perceive the MIC after its recent party elections?

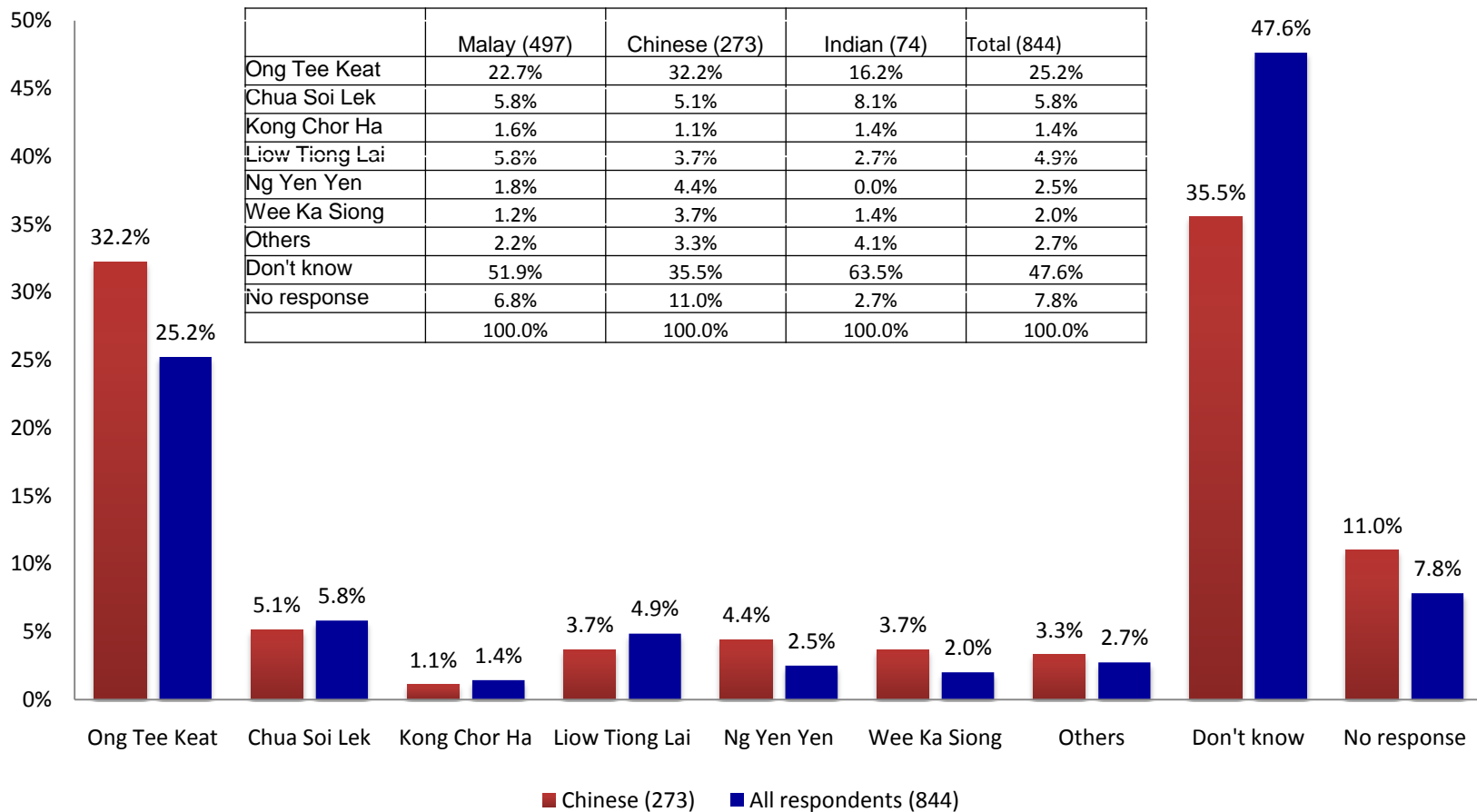

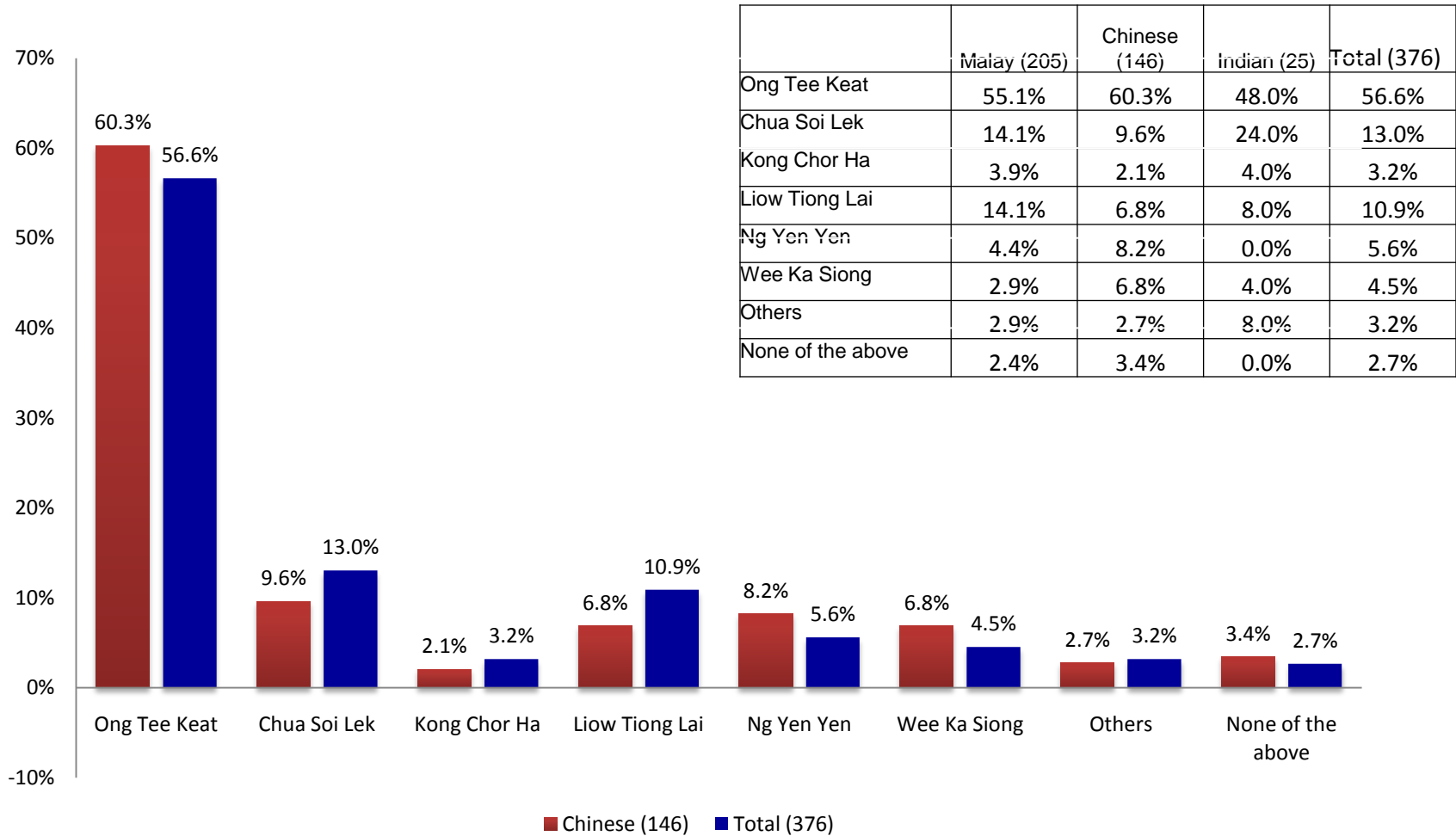
MCA Leadership- pt1

Who do you think should lead the MCA?



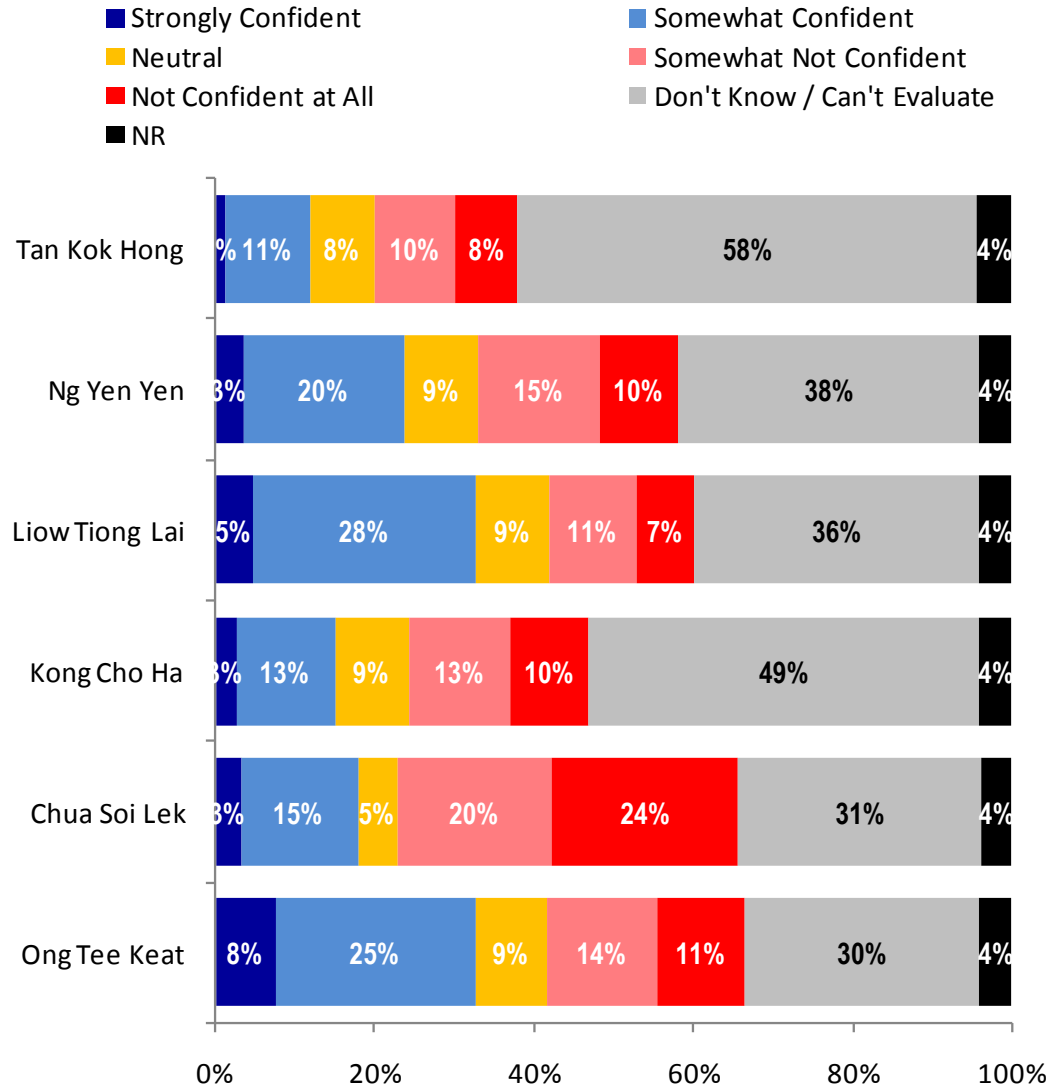
MCA Leadership - pt2

Who do you think should lead the MCA (excluding those who “don’t know” and did not respond)?



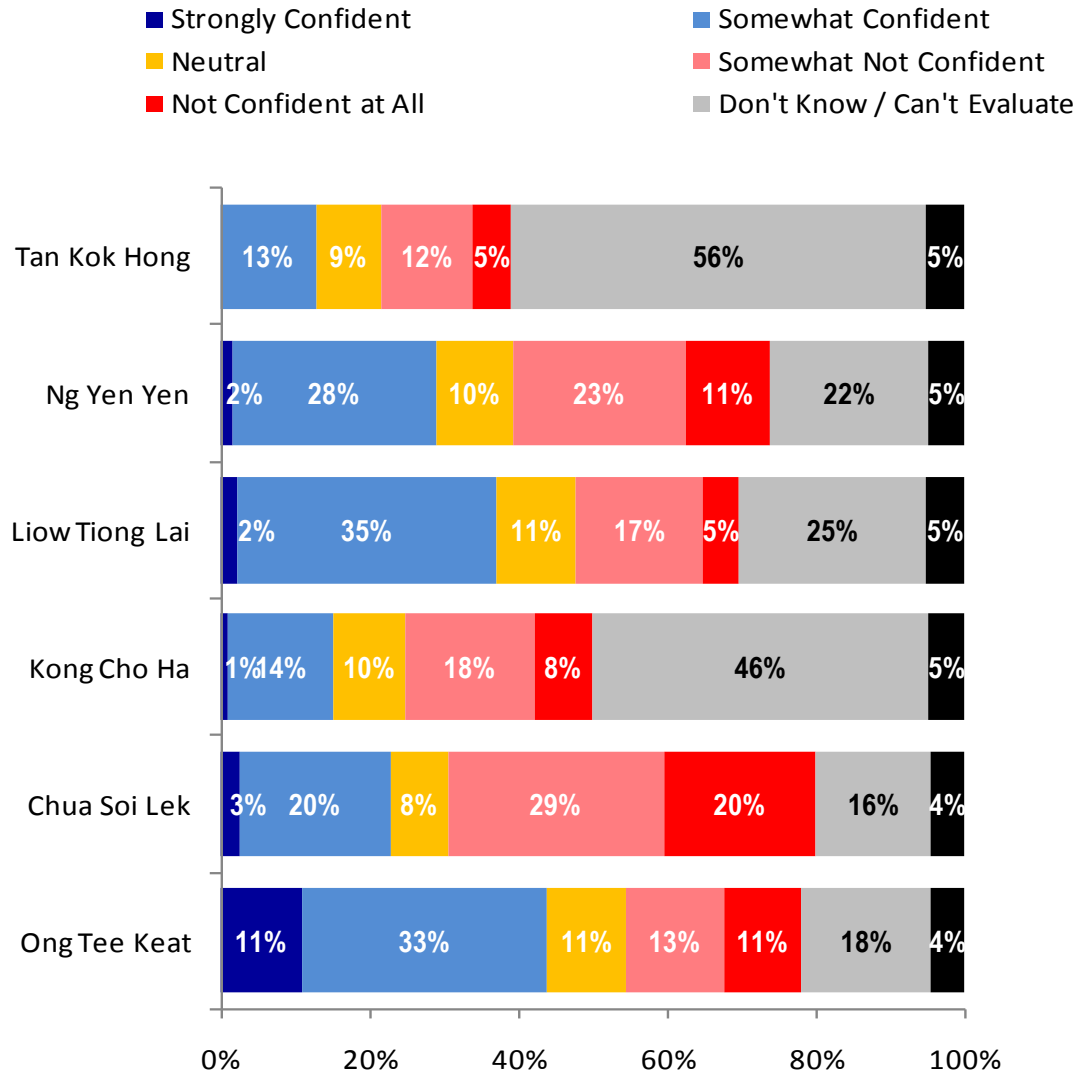
Confidence in MCA Leaders – pt1

How do you view the following MCA personalities, ... (all respondents)



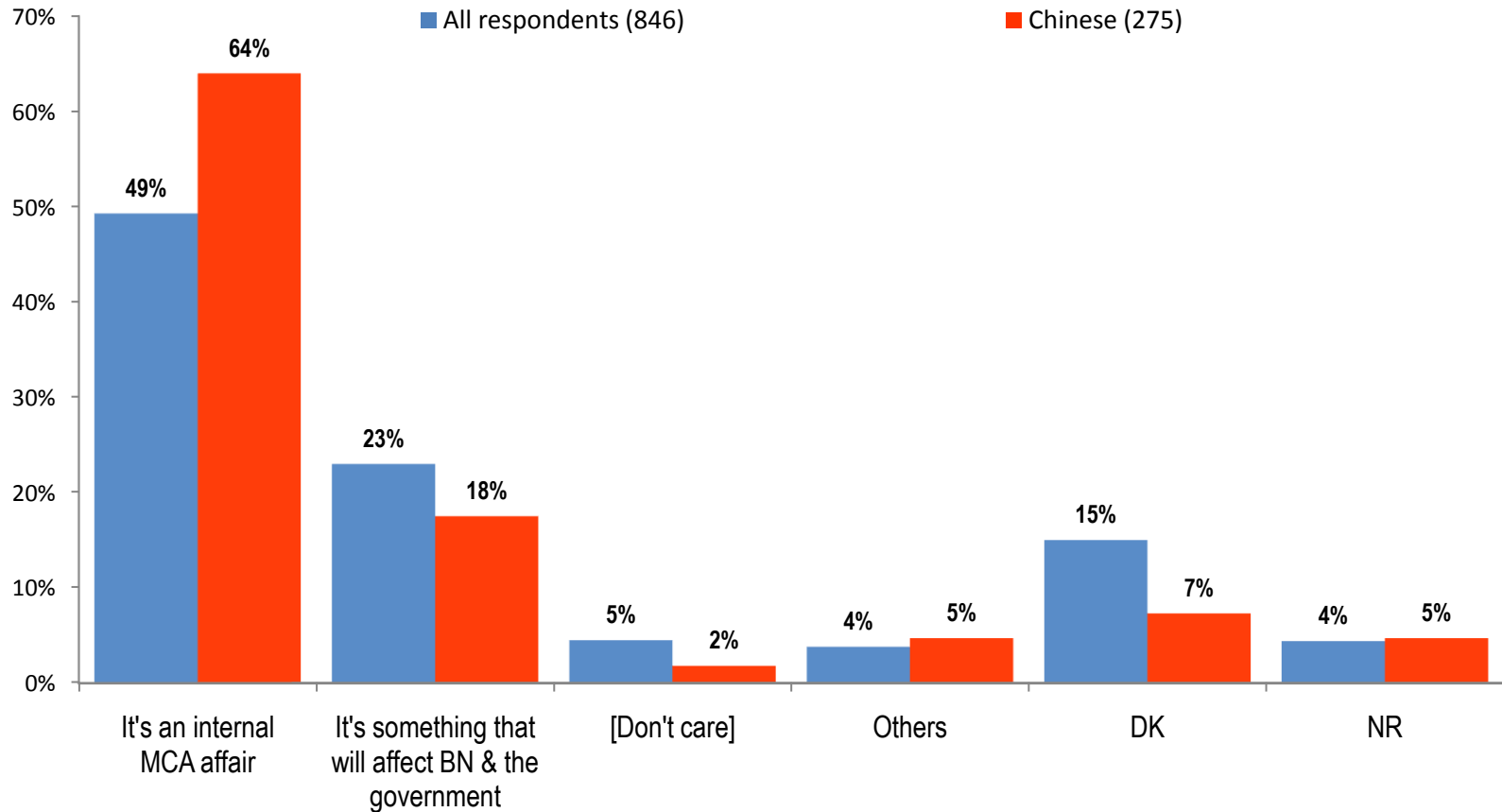

Of the two statements provided, which one is closest to your view on the problems experienced by the MCA? (All respondents & Chinese only)

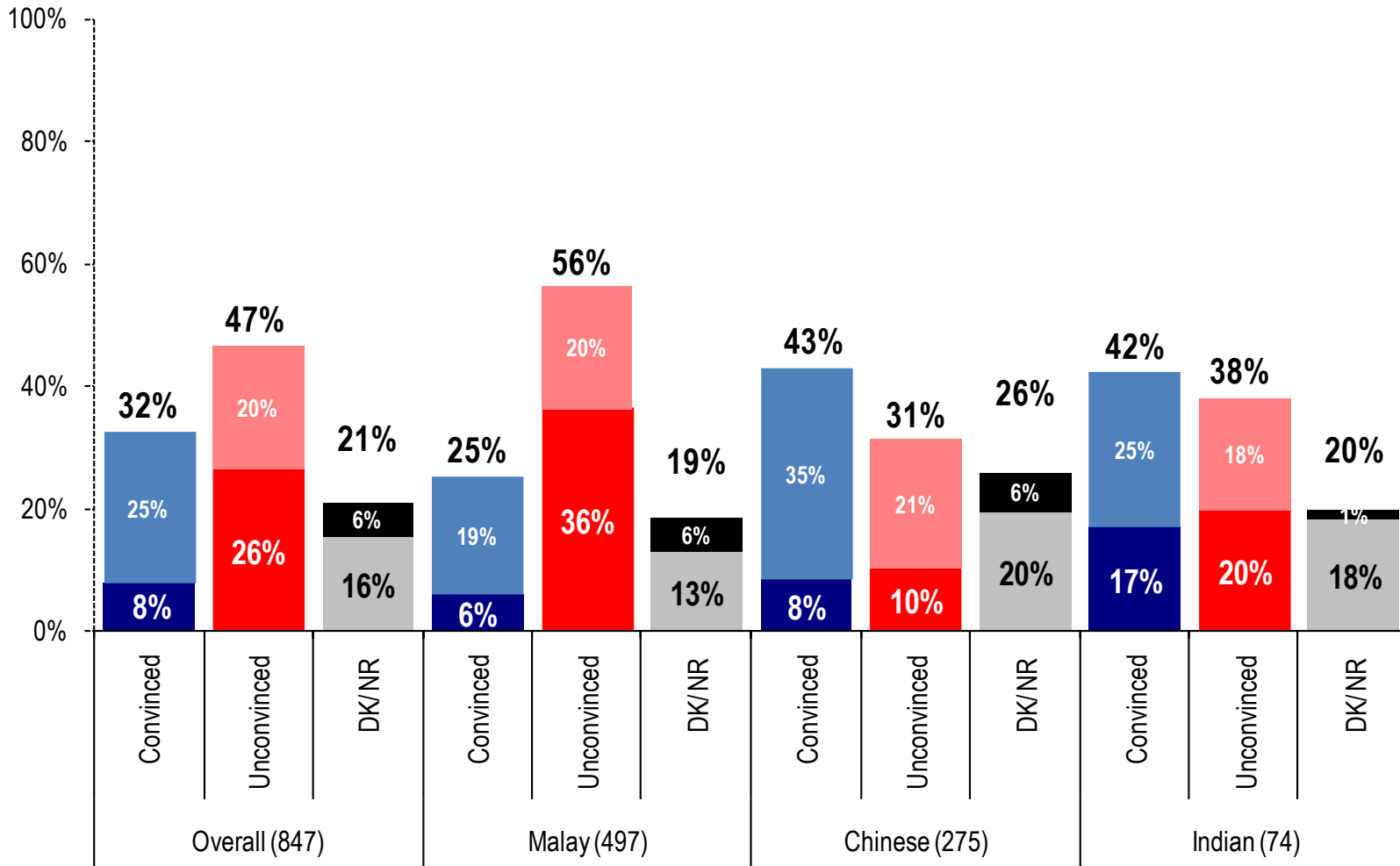

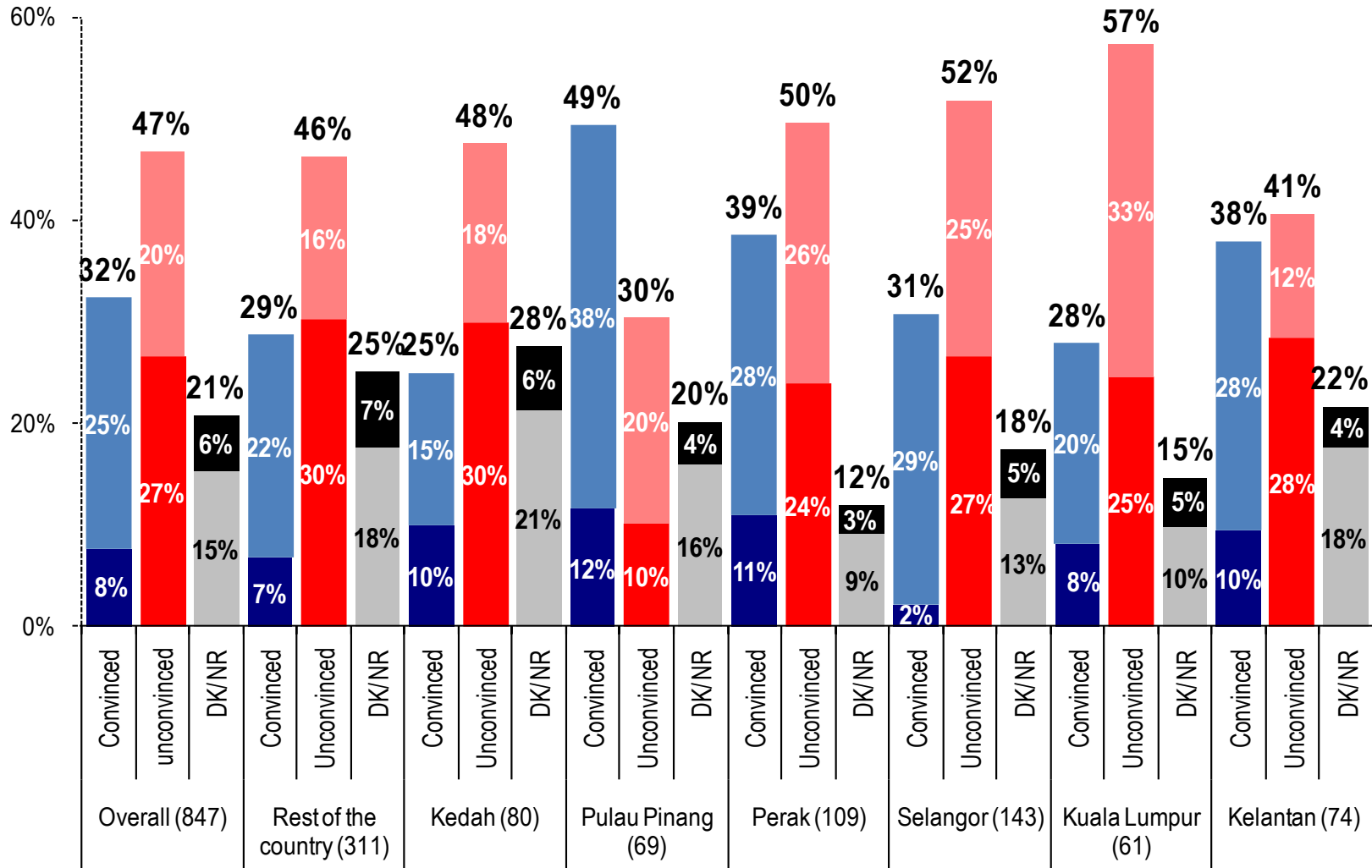
Viability of Pakatan Rakyat at Federal level

How convinced or not convinced are you that Pakatan Rakyat can be a viable alternative to BN?



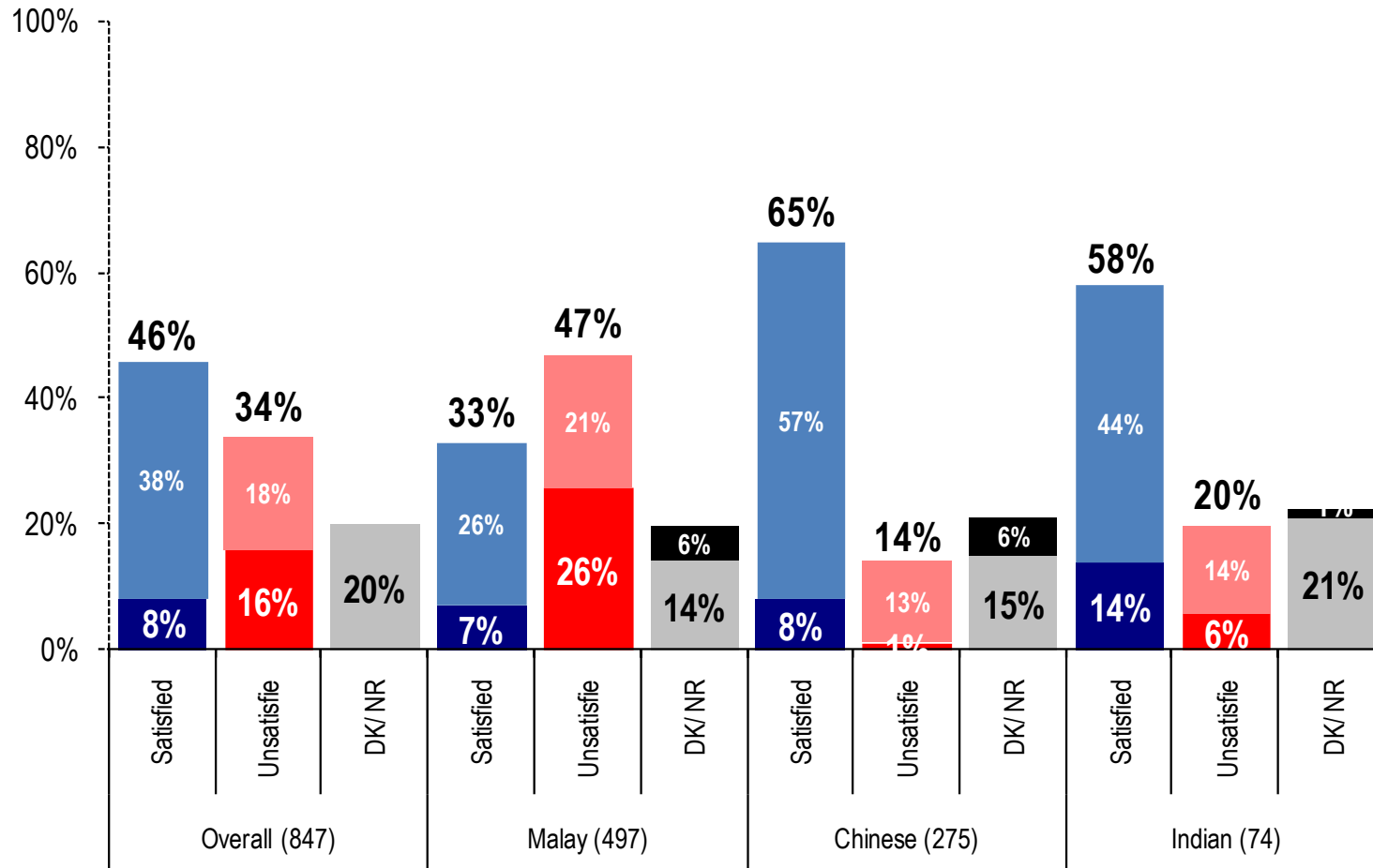

How convinced or not convinced are you that Pakatan Rakyat can be a viable alternative to BN?



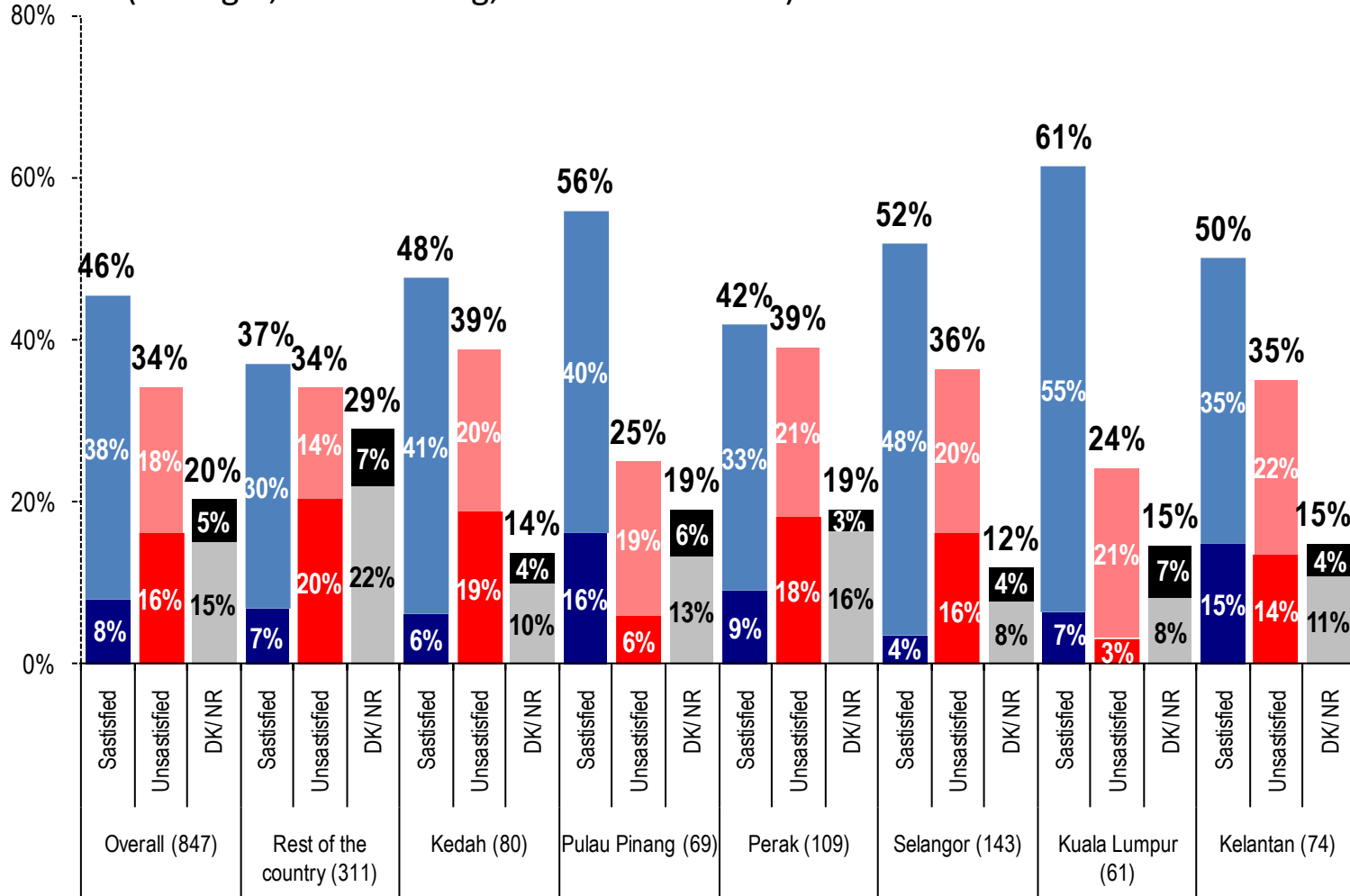
Viability of Pakatan Rakyat at State Level

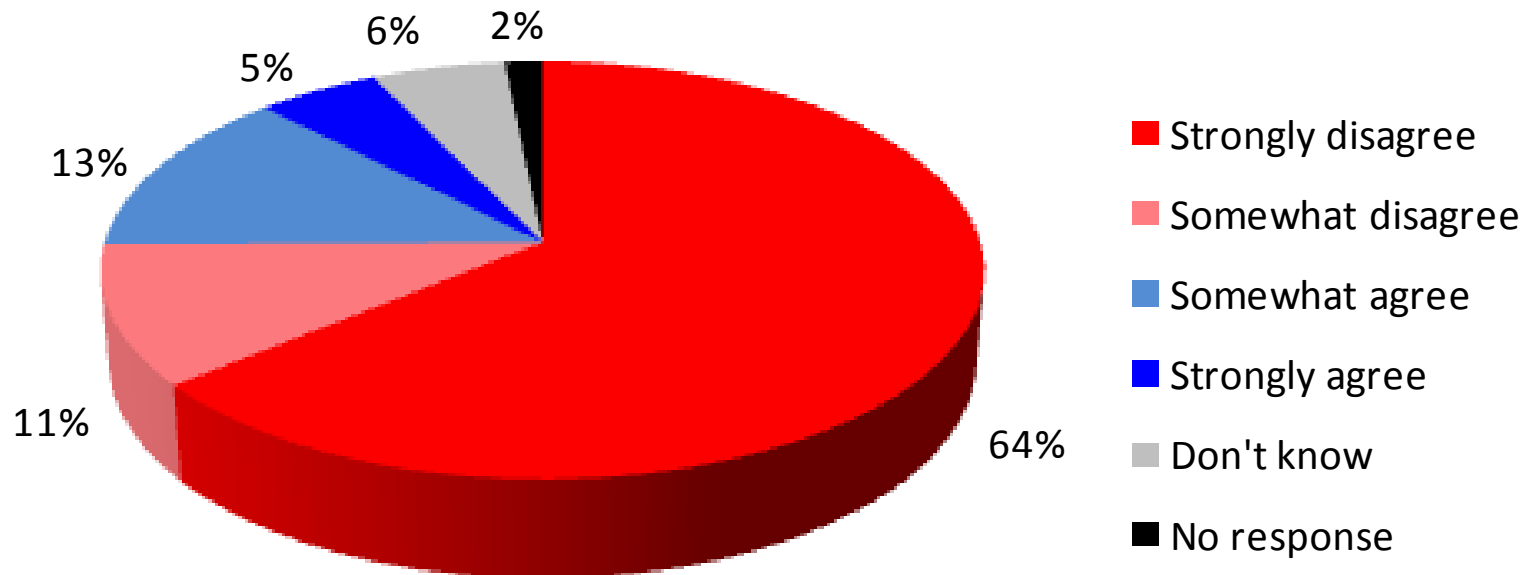

Acceptance of leaders tainted with sex scandals

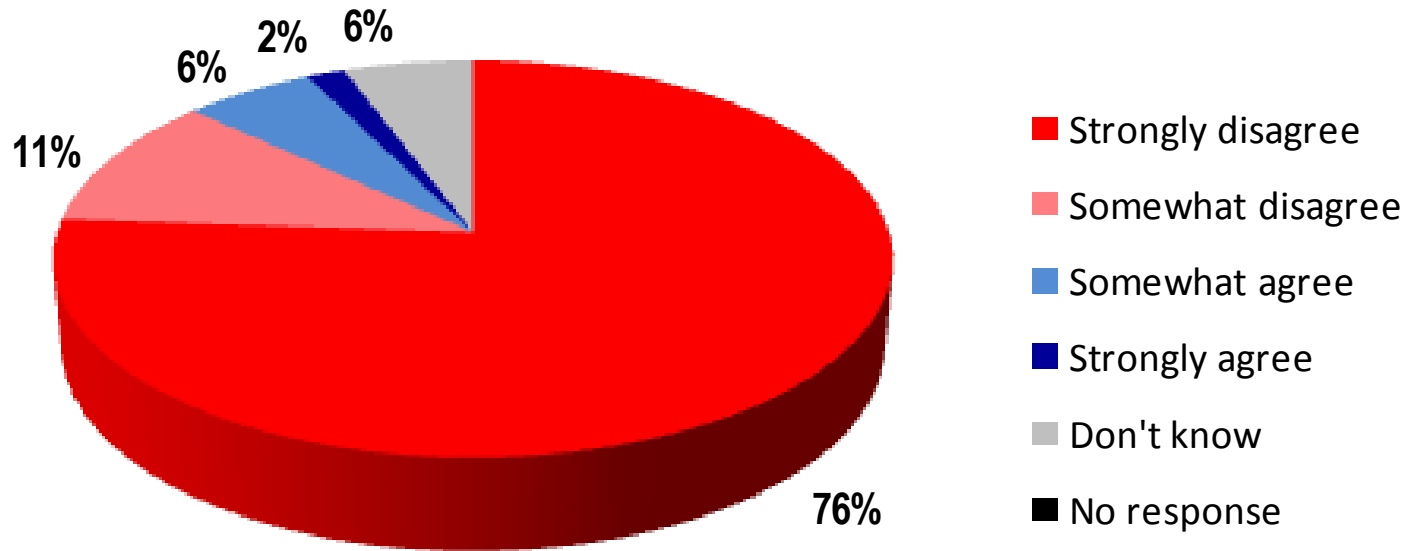
Do you agree or disagree that a leader tainted by sex scandal can lead a major political party?

Do you agree or disagree that a leader charged with money politics in party election should be allowed to stand in by-election or general election?



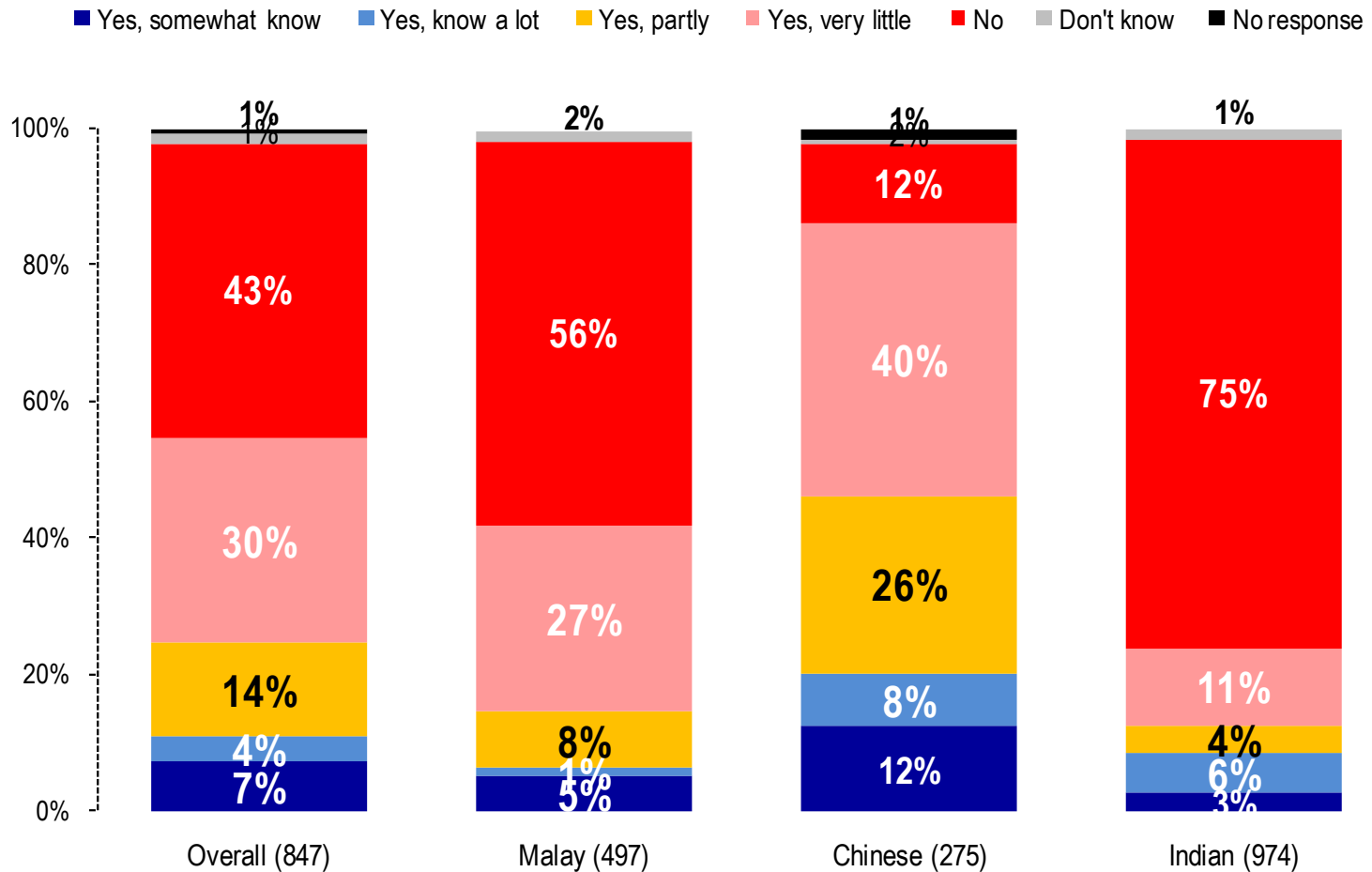
