

Methodology

- 1018 randomly selected registered voters aged 21+ were interviewed via telephone for the survey
- Respondents were selected via random stratified sampling method along the lines of state of residence, ethnicity, gender and age
- Survey was carried out between 26 Dec 08 and 2 Jan 09.
- Survey margin of error estimated at ±3.10%
- Important Recent Events during polling period: Announcement of PAS candidate for Kuala Terengganu by-election, Gunung Rapat elected village head, Christmas and New Year celebrations.





What is the most important issue or problem in the country today?








How satisfied or dissatisfied are you with the federal government's performance on that issue?




How satisfied or dissatisfied are you with Abdullah Ahmad Badawi's performance as Prime Minister?









In your view, how strongly do you agree or disagree that Najib Tun Razak would make a good prime minister?




In your view, how strongly do you agree or disagree that Najib Tun Razak would make a good prime minister?






How confident or not confident are you that the Judicial Appointment Commission will be able to bring about greater independence of the judiciary?





How strongly do you agree or disagree to the teaching of science and mathematics subjects in English from primary to secondary schools?








Among the statements stated below, what is your expectation for the new MCA lineup?






How strongly can you accept or not accept a leader who to hold a senior government post?
