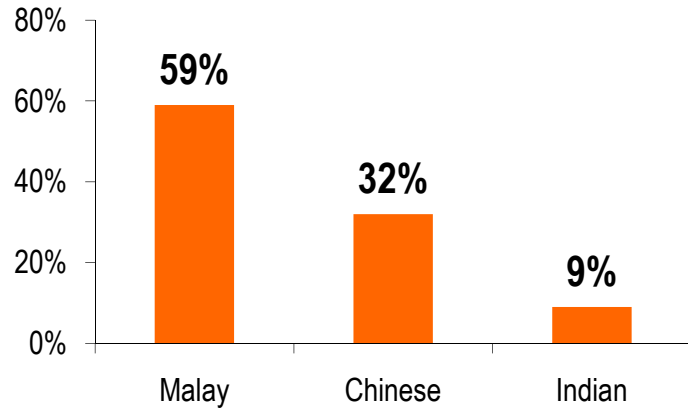
Methodology

- **1028** randomly selected **registered voters** aged 21+ were interviewed via telephone for the survey
- Respondents were selected via random stratified sampling method along the lines of state of residence, ethnicity, gender and age
- Survey was carried out between 6th – 16th May 2010
- Survey margin of error estimated at $\pm 3.10\%$
- Important events during survey period: Sibul by-election, debate on Aminulrasyid and other police shooting cases, cancellation of May 13 Malay assembly in Kuala Terengganu by GERTAK, announcement of sports betting licence, MP of Wangsa Maju quit PKR & allegation of abuse of power in Selangor sand mining.

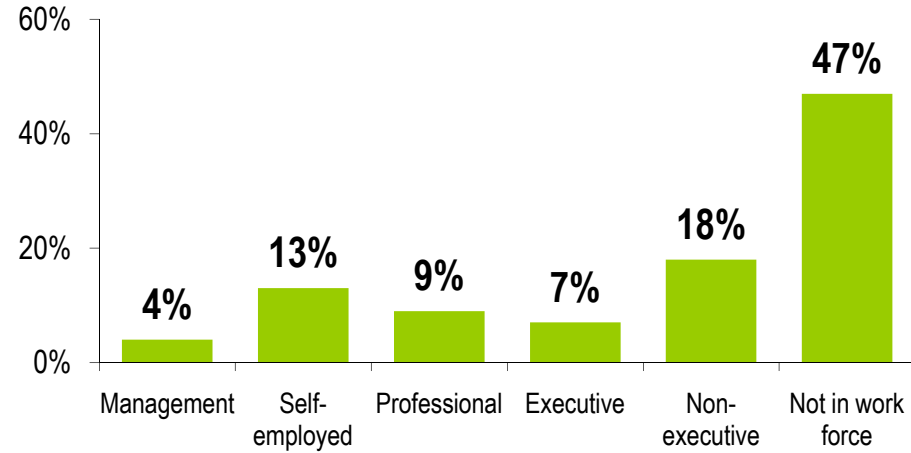

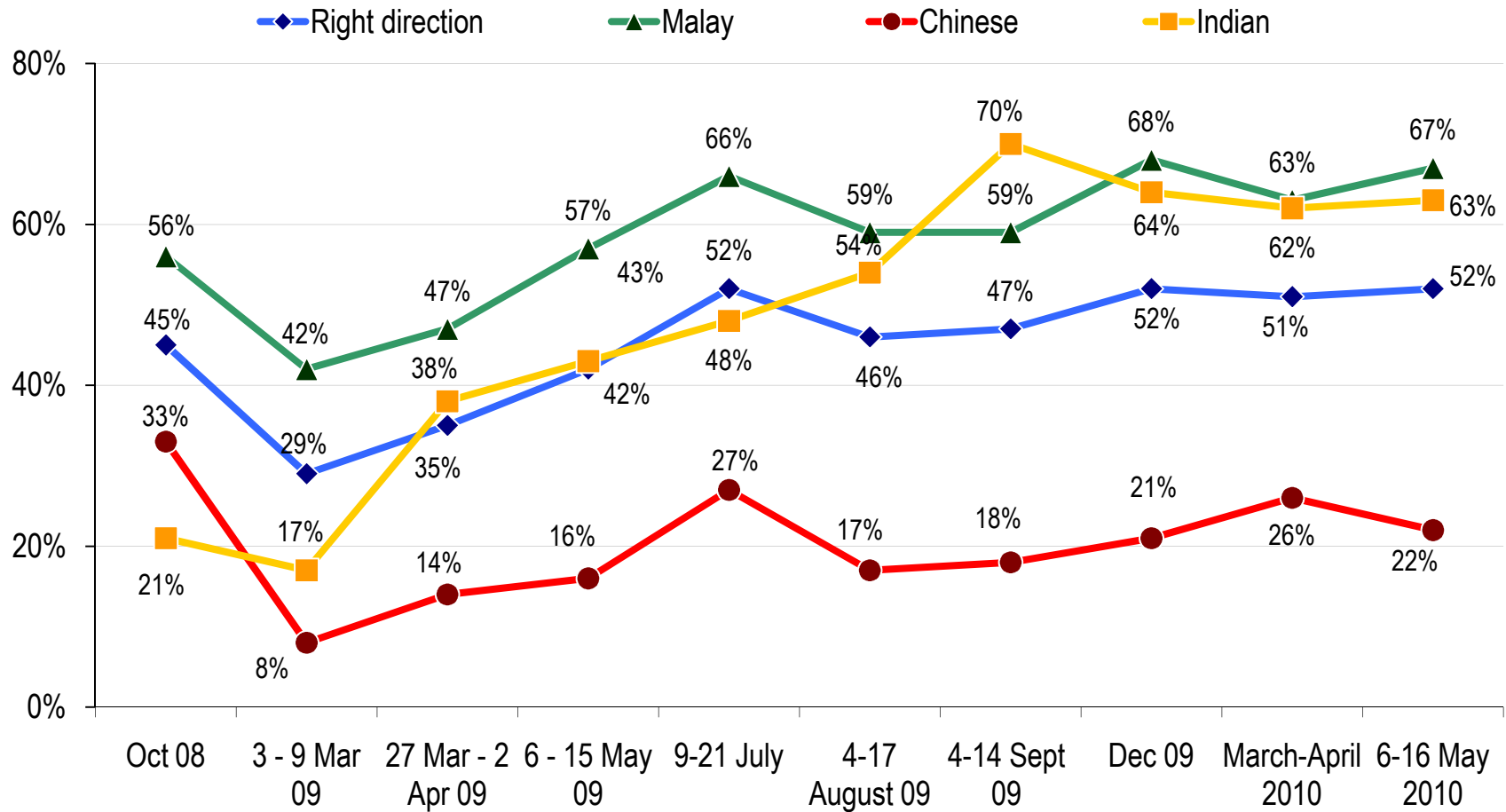
Considering the conditions in the country today, how strongly would you say that things are heading in the right or wrong direction?

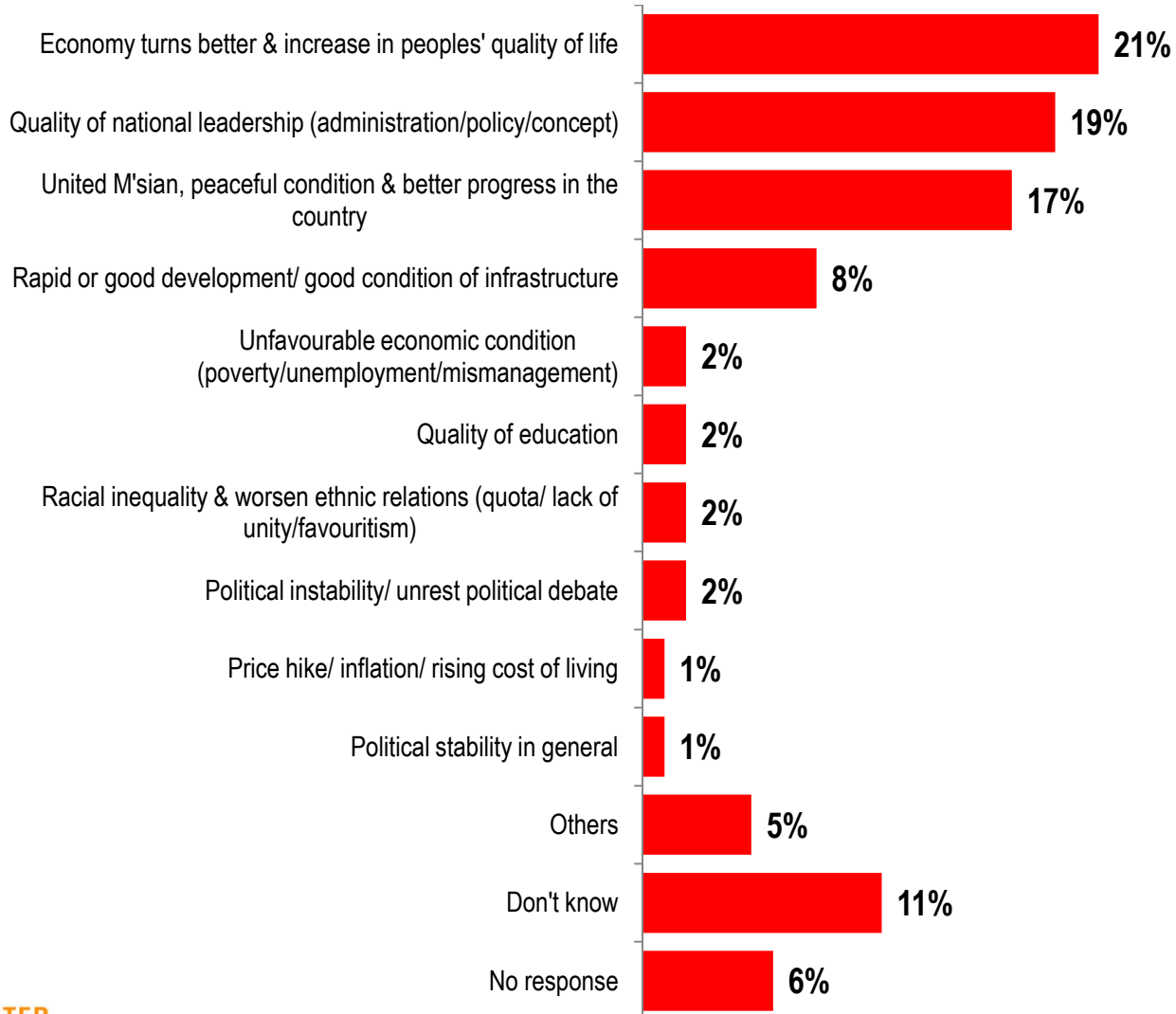


Considering the conditions in the country today, how strongly would you say that things are heading in the right or wrong direction?



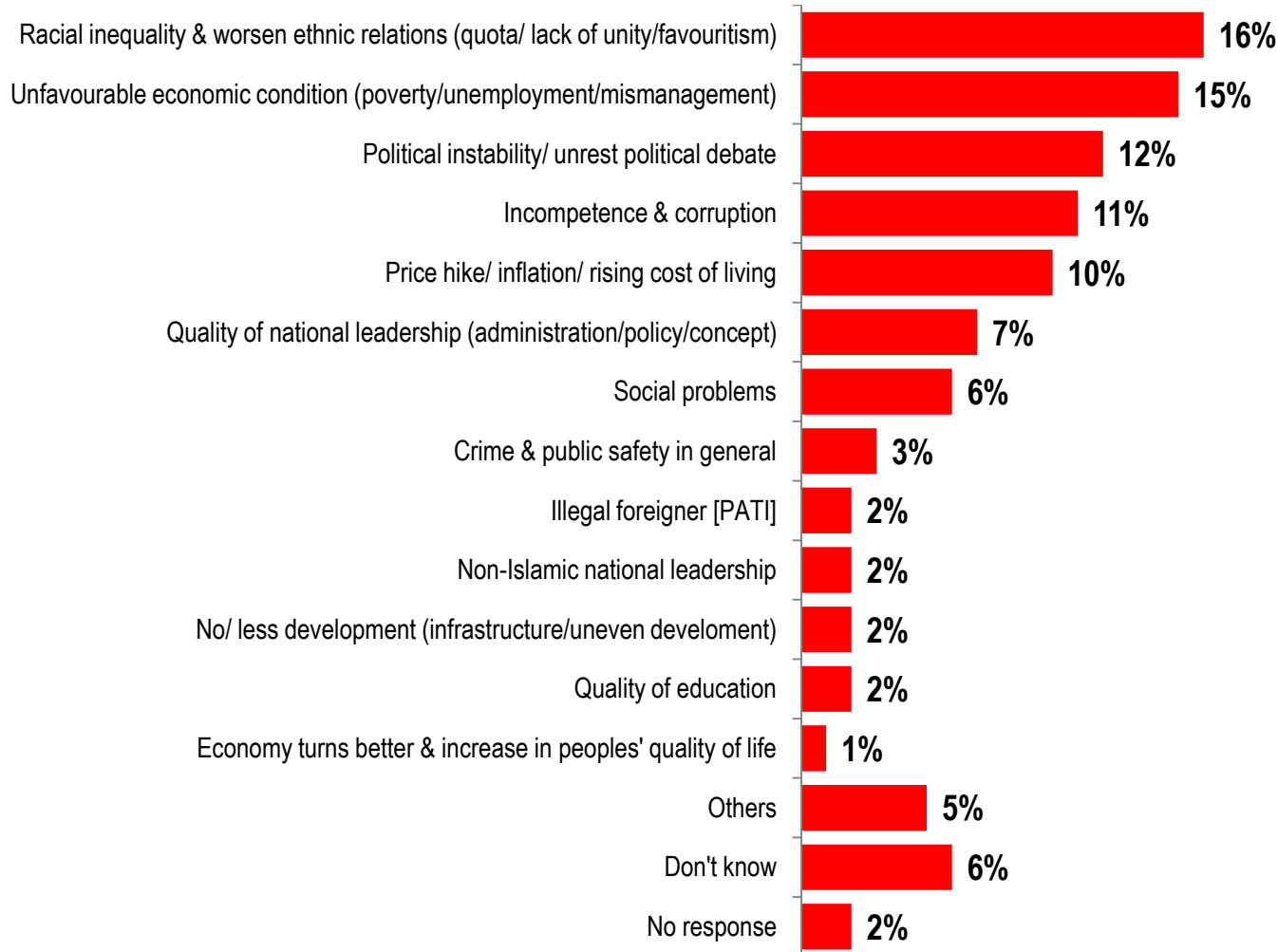

And what would you say is the issue that is the main reason for your answer?

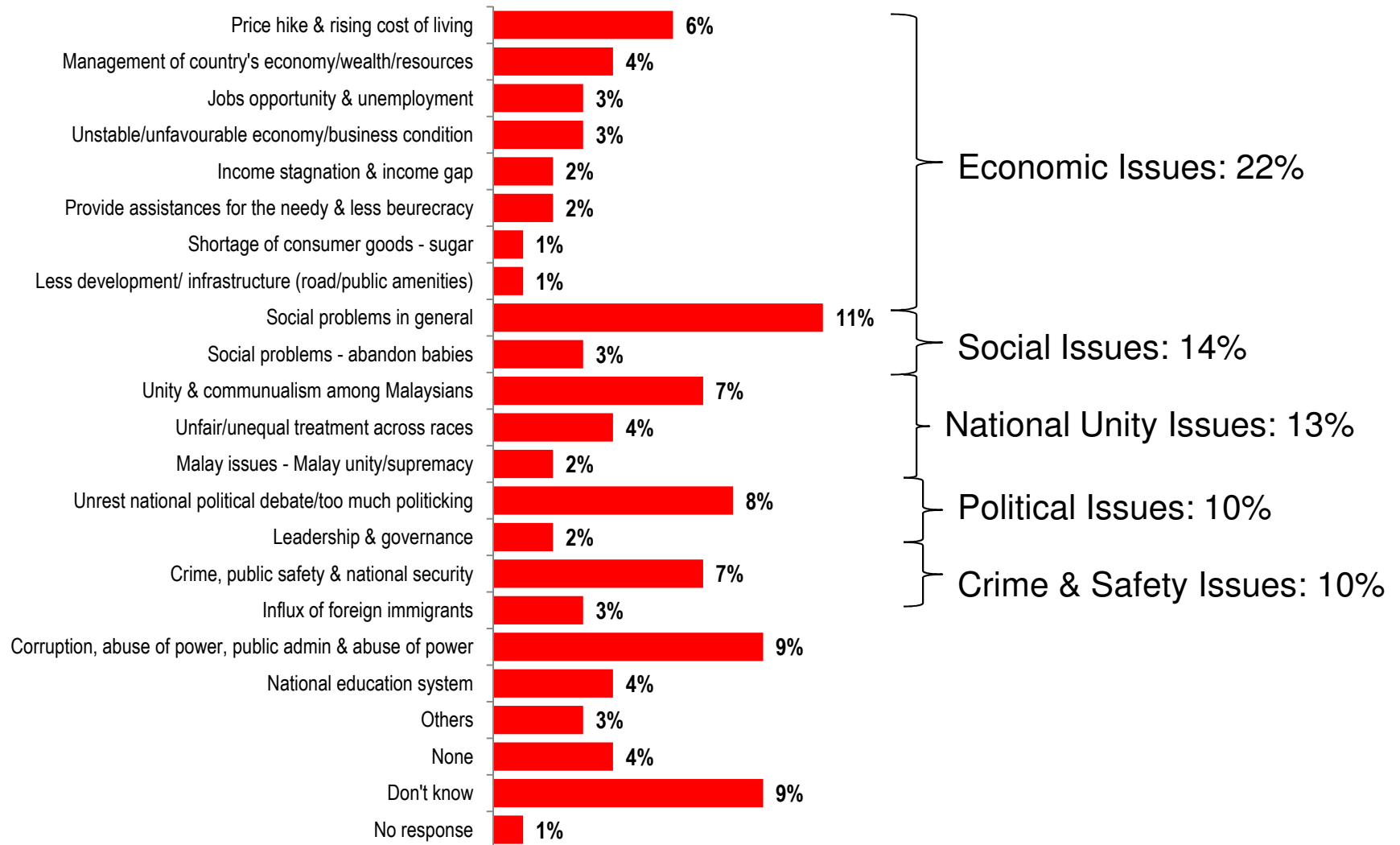

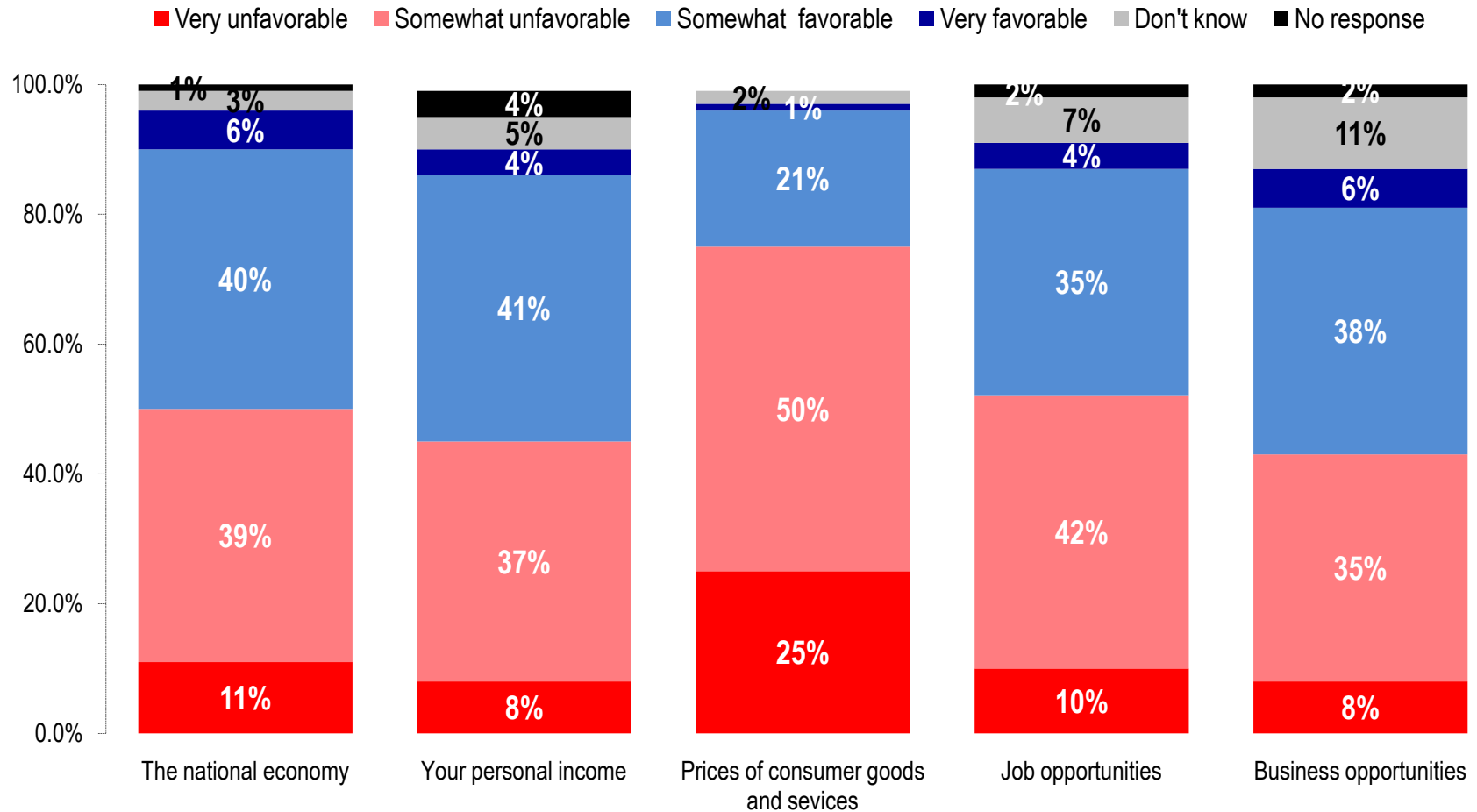

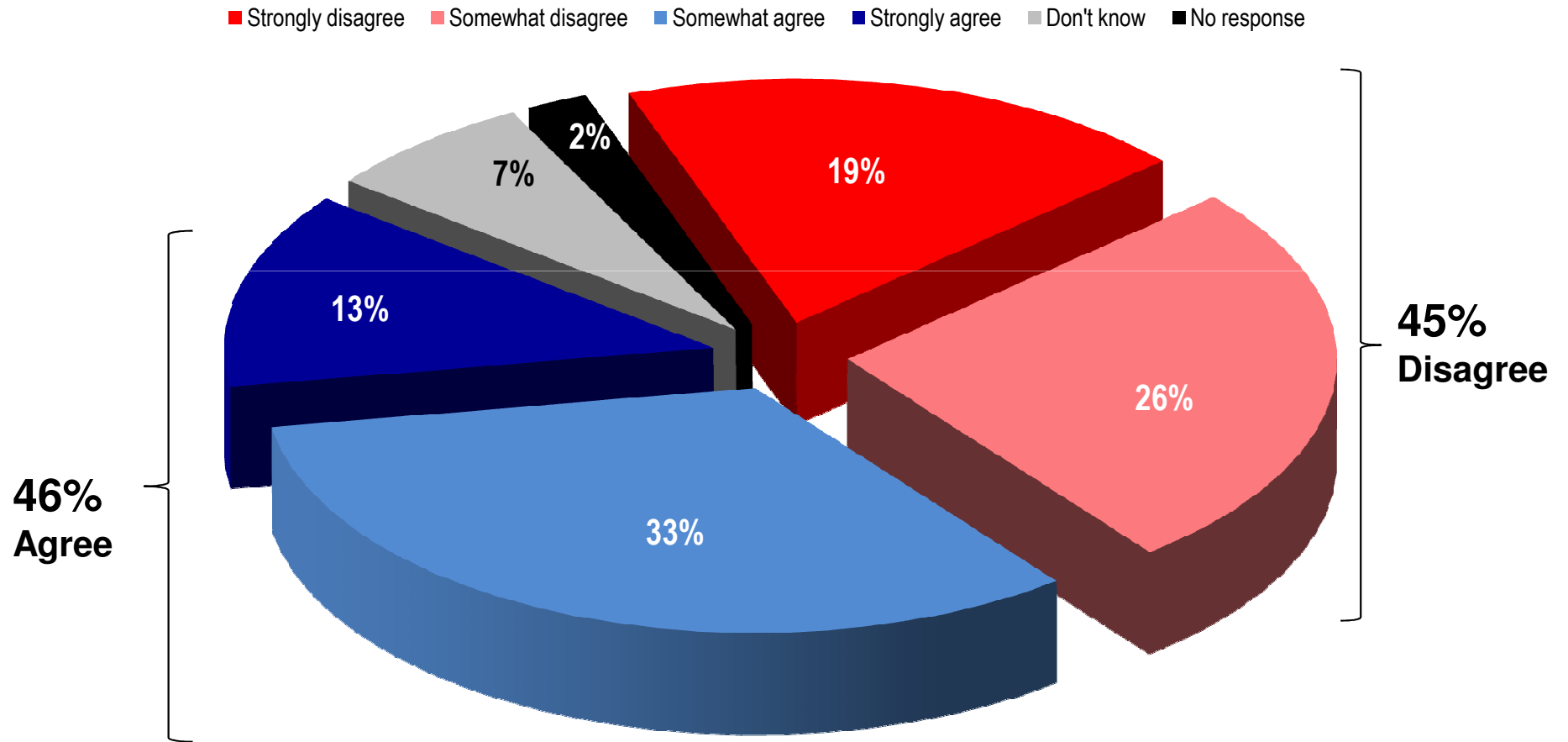
How do you expect our country's economy to be one year from now?

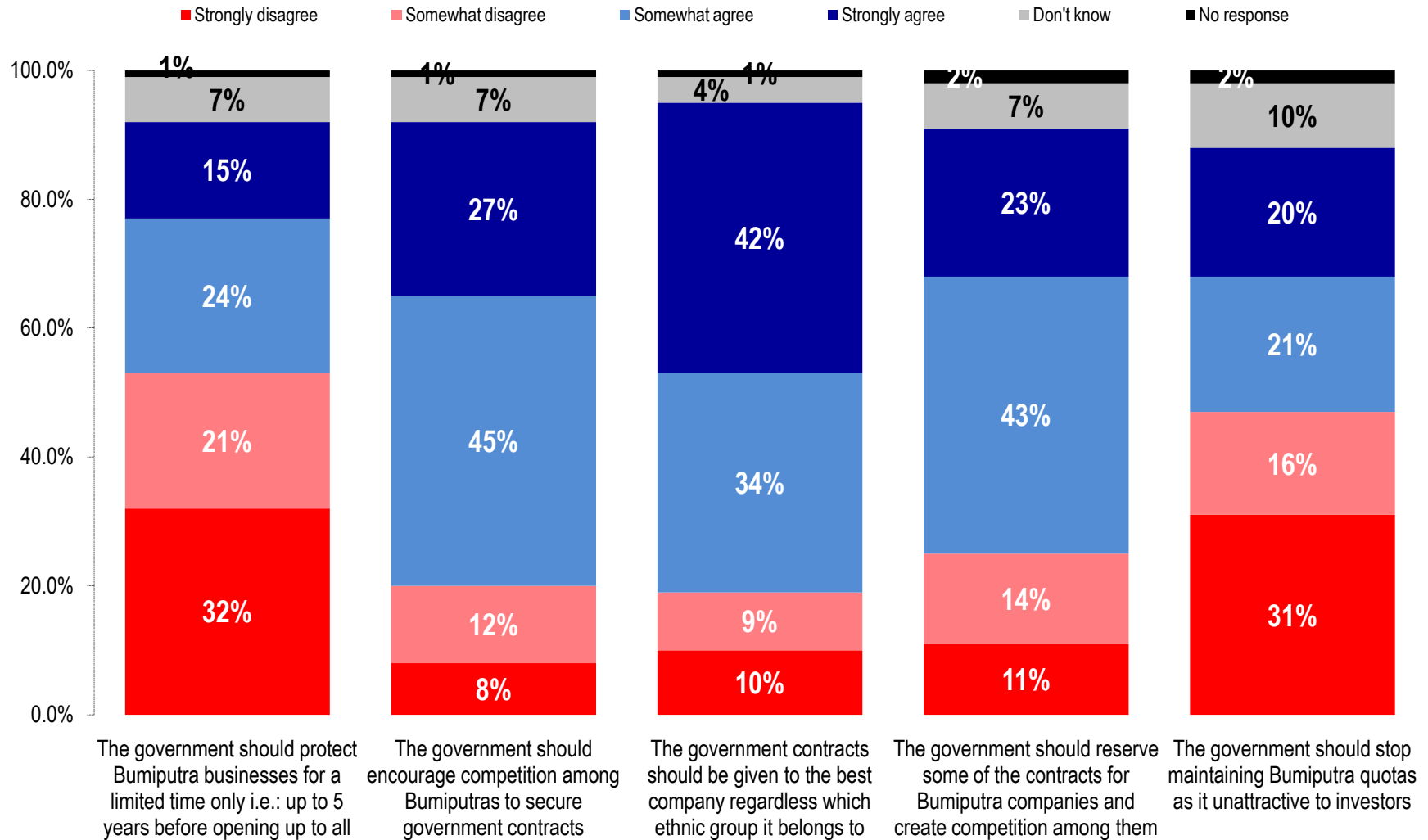

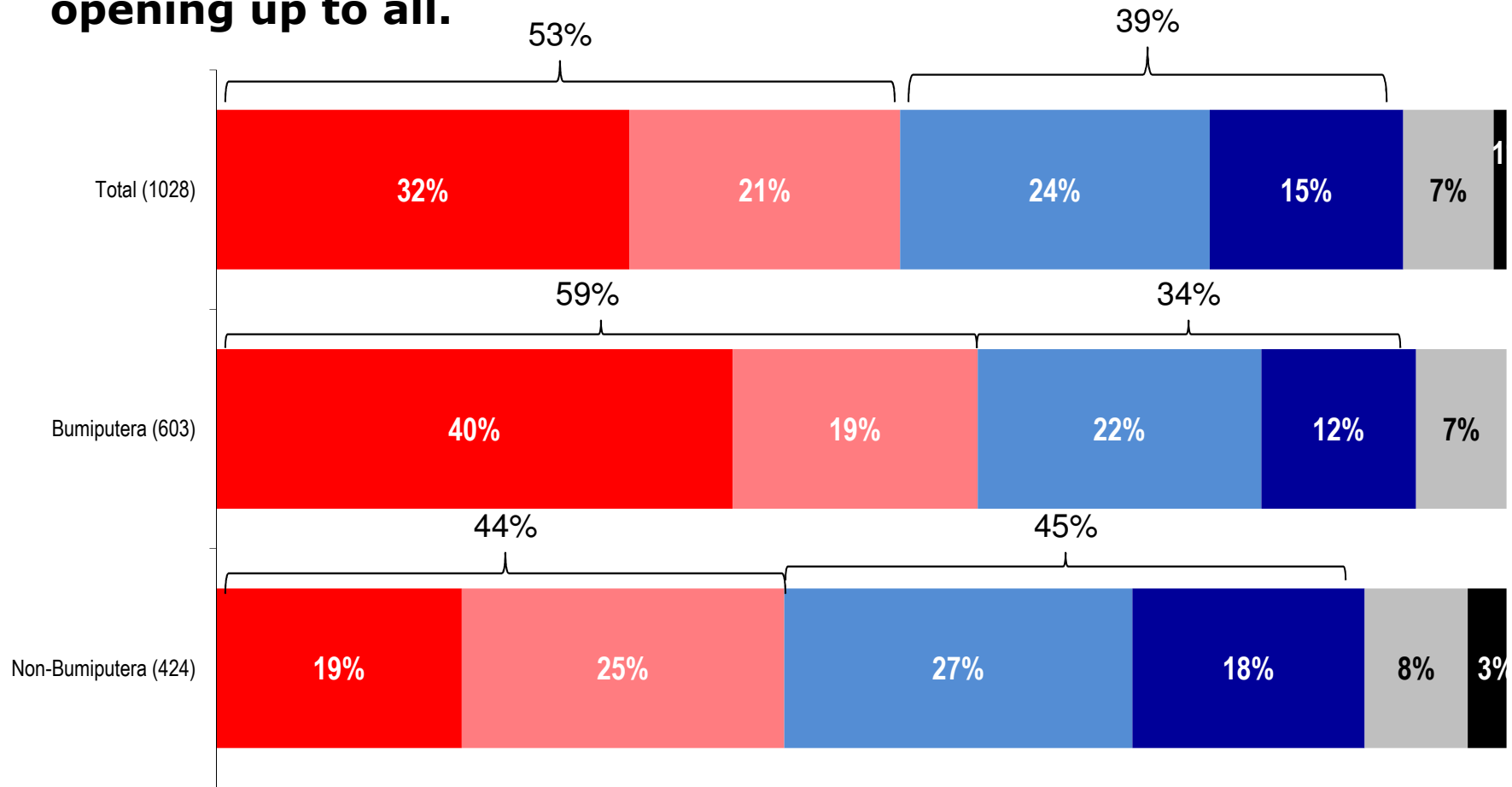

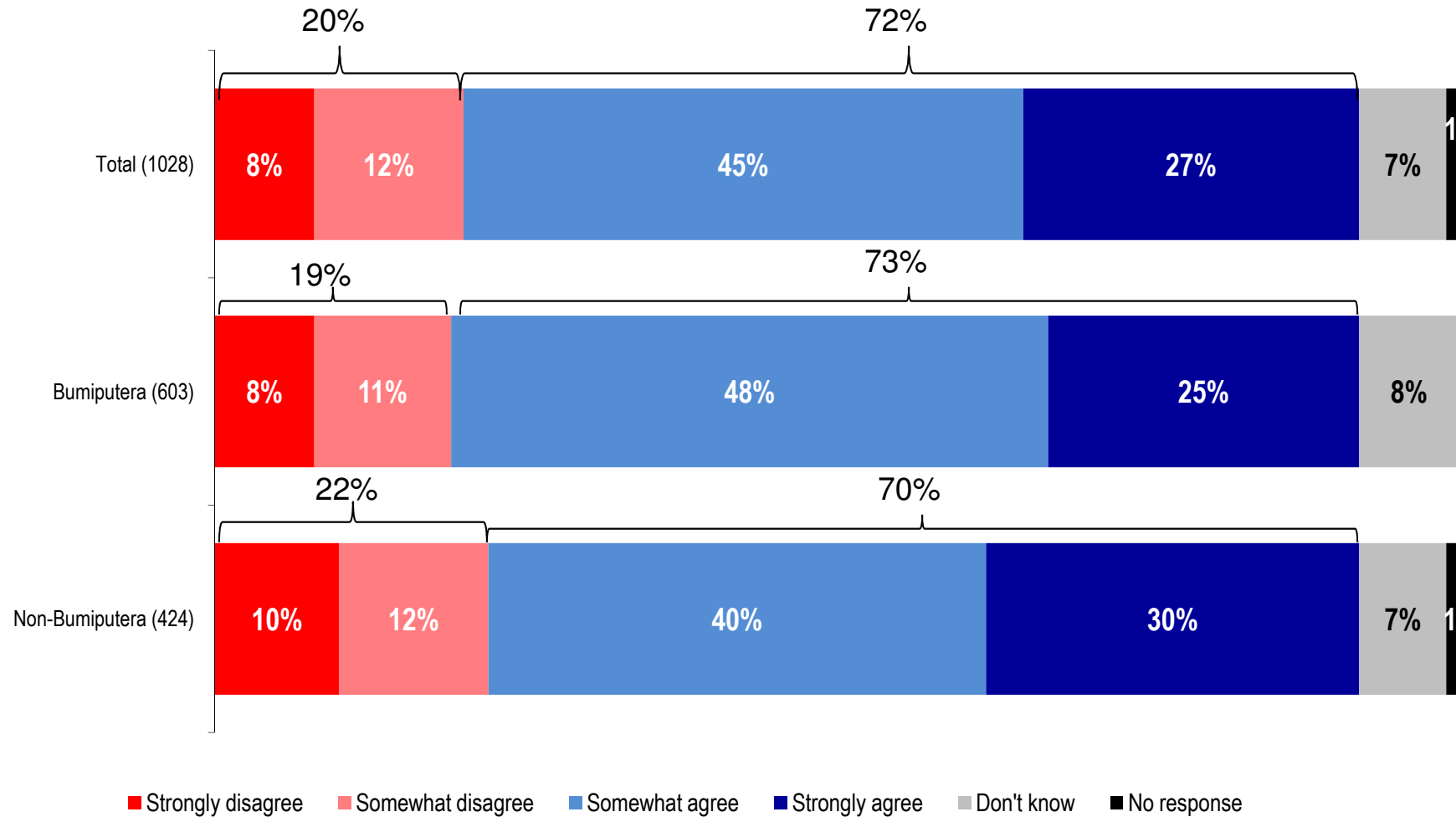

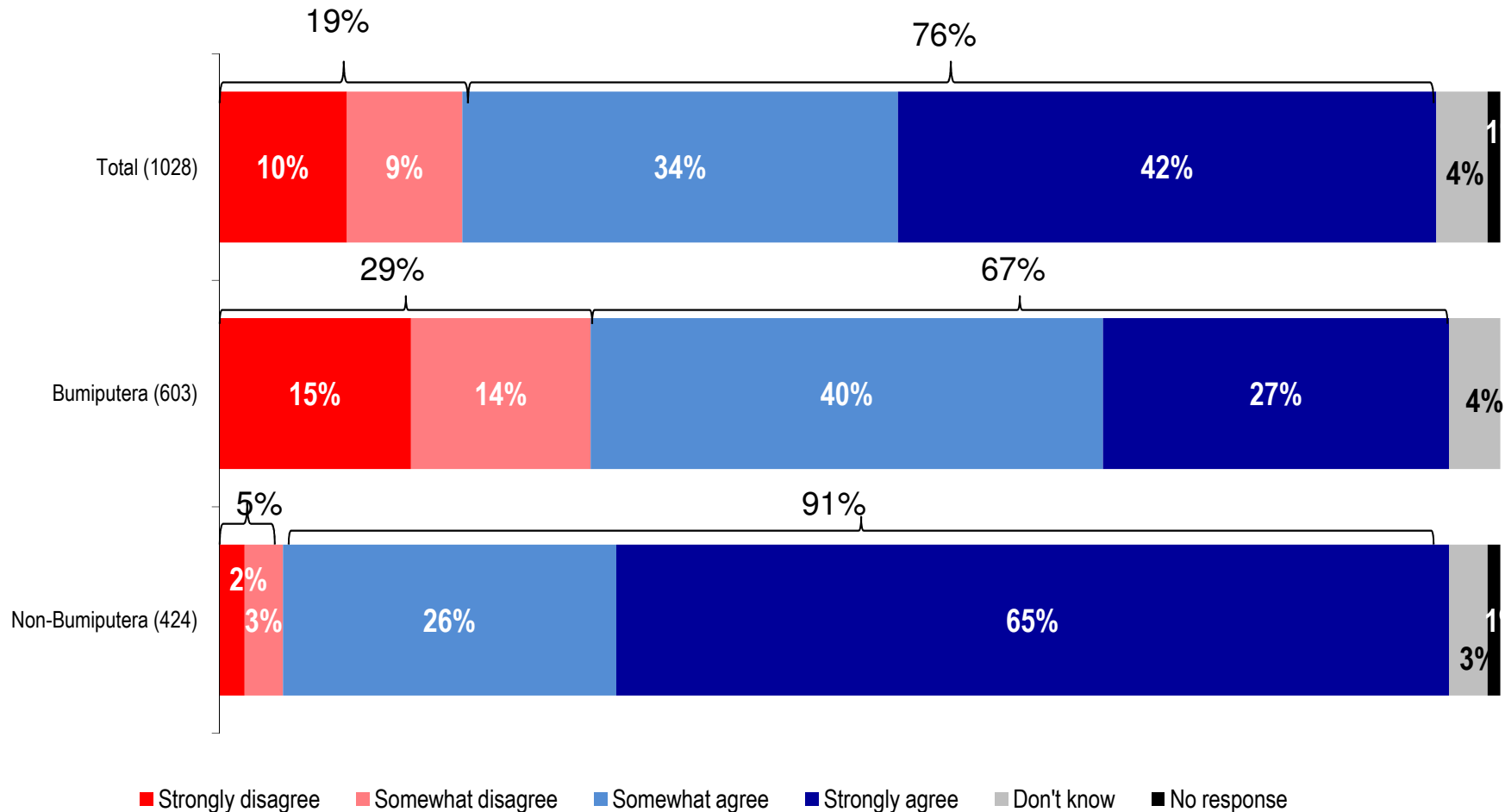

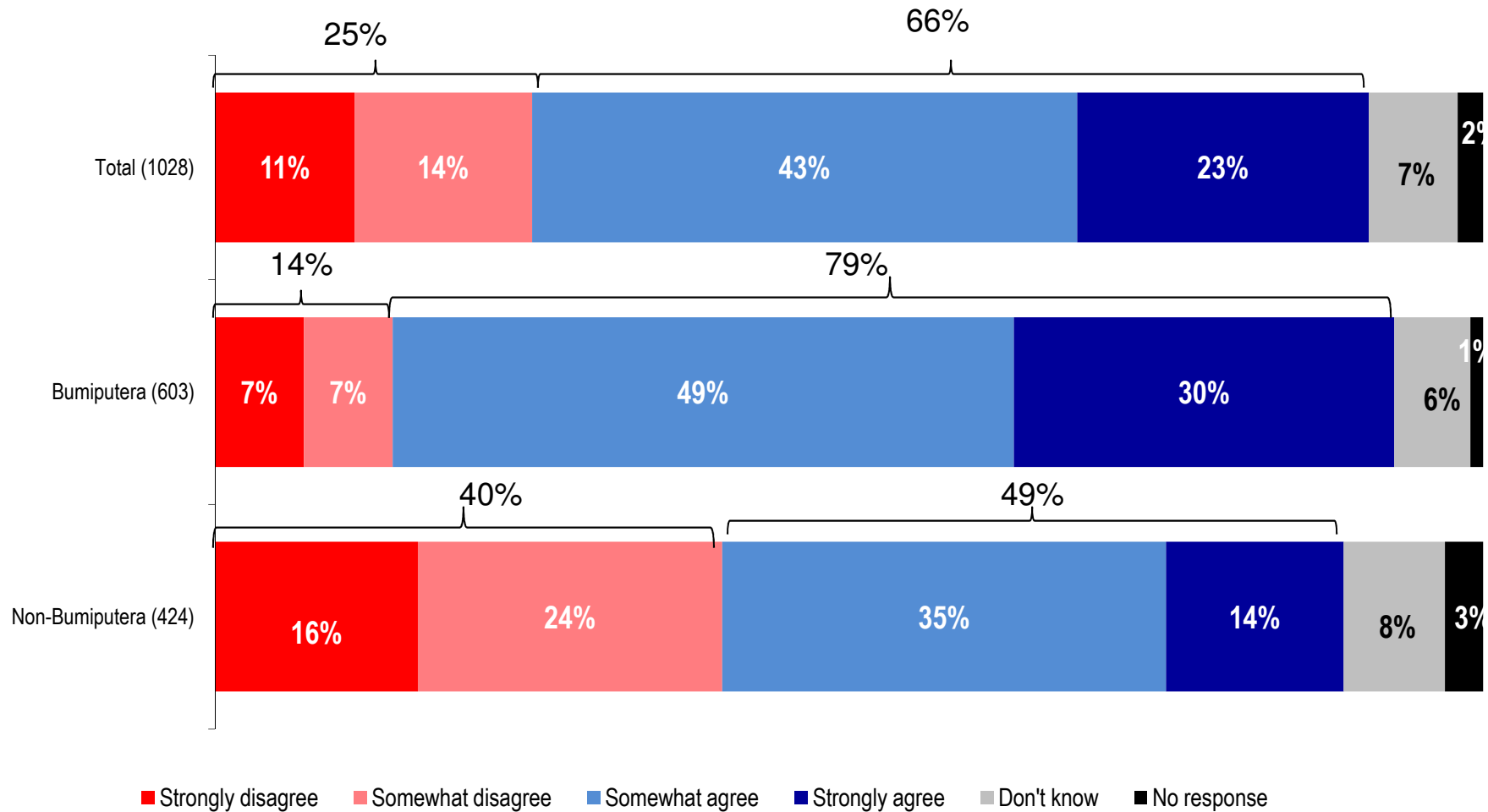

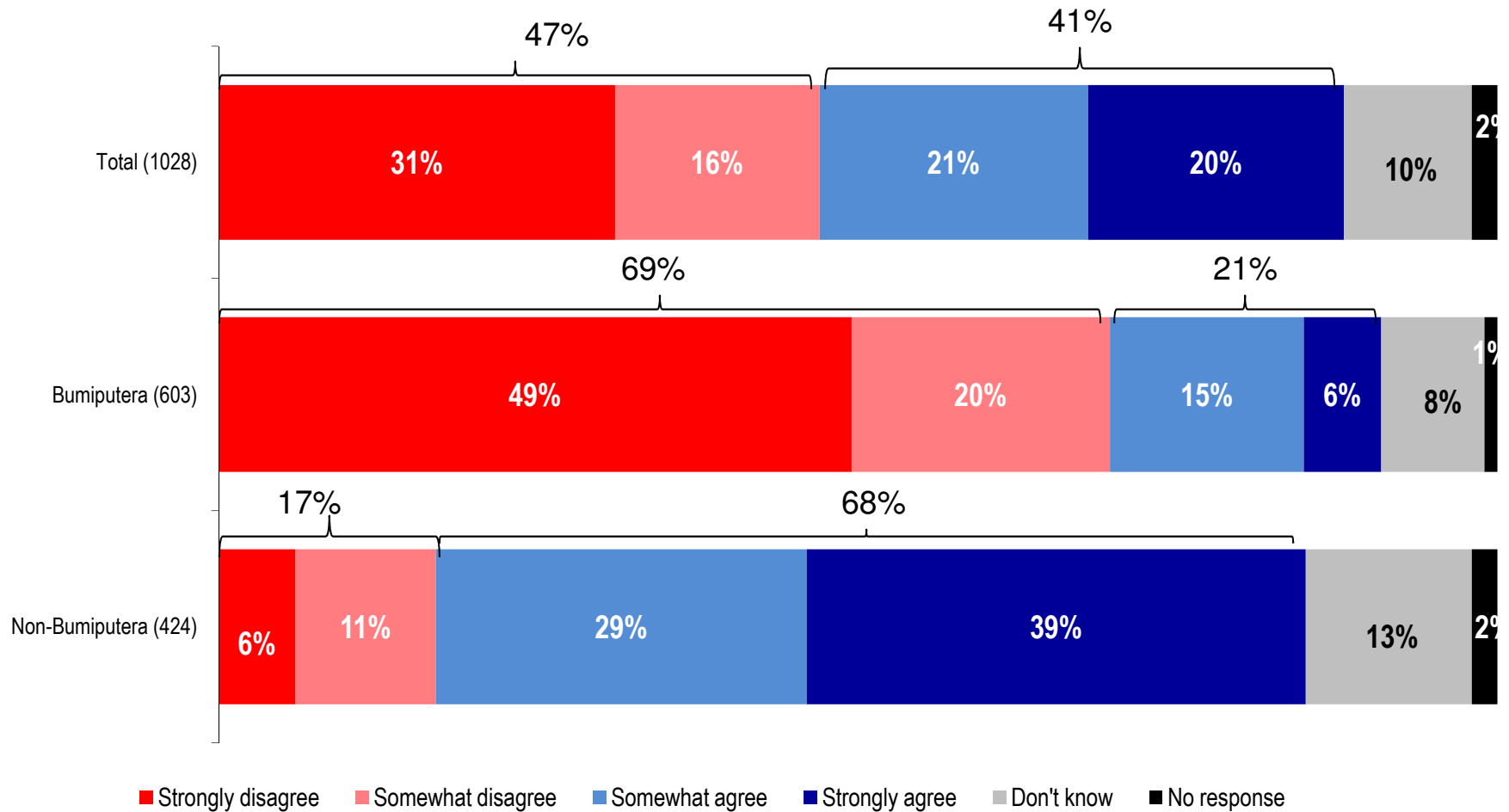

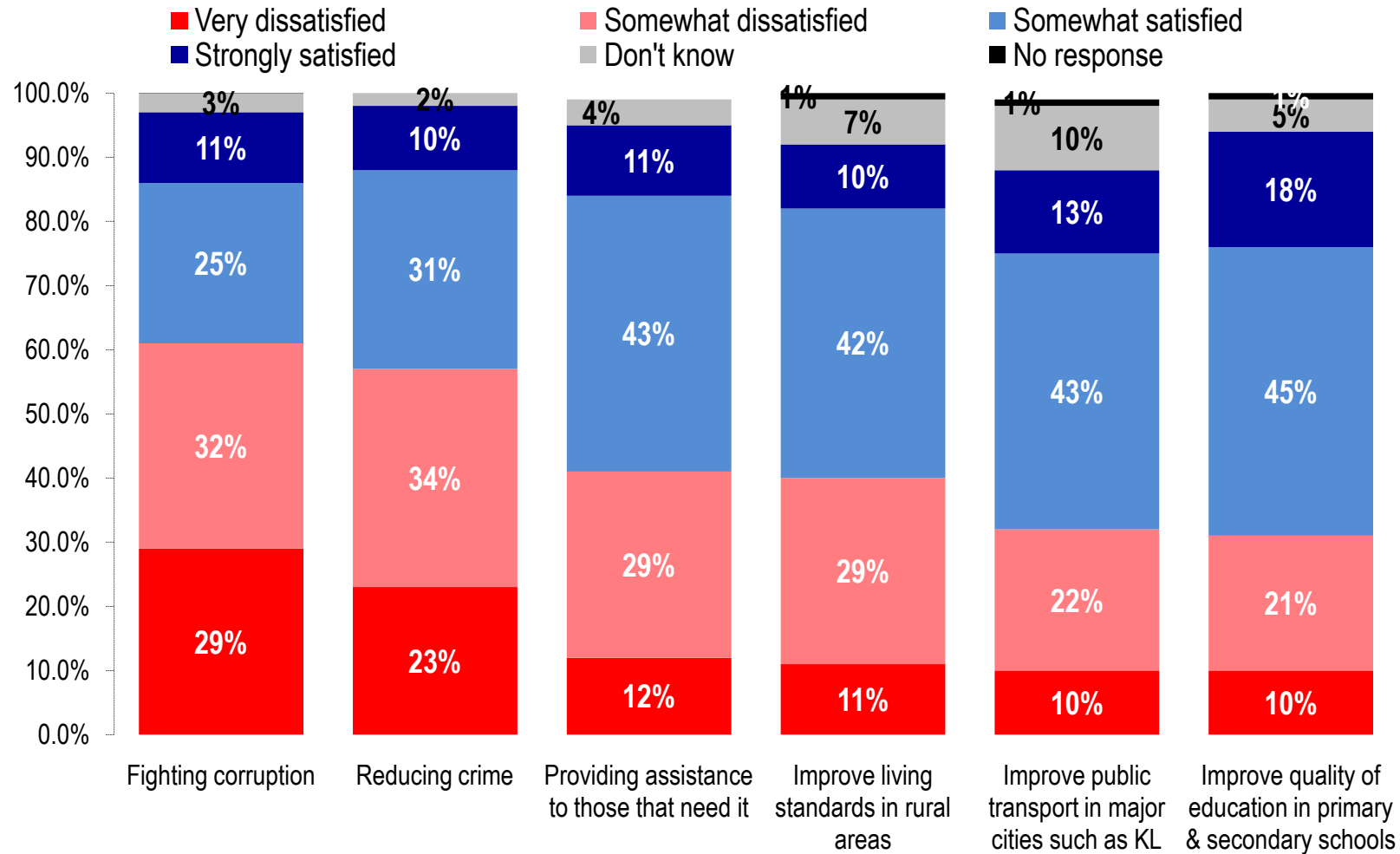

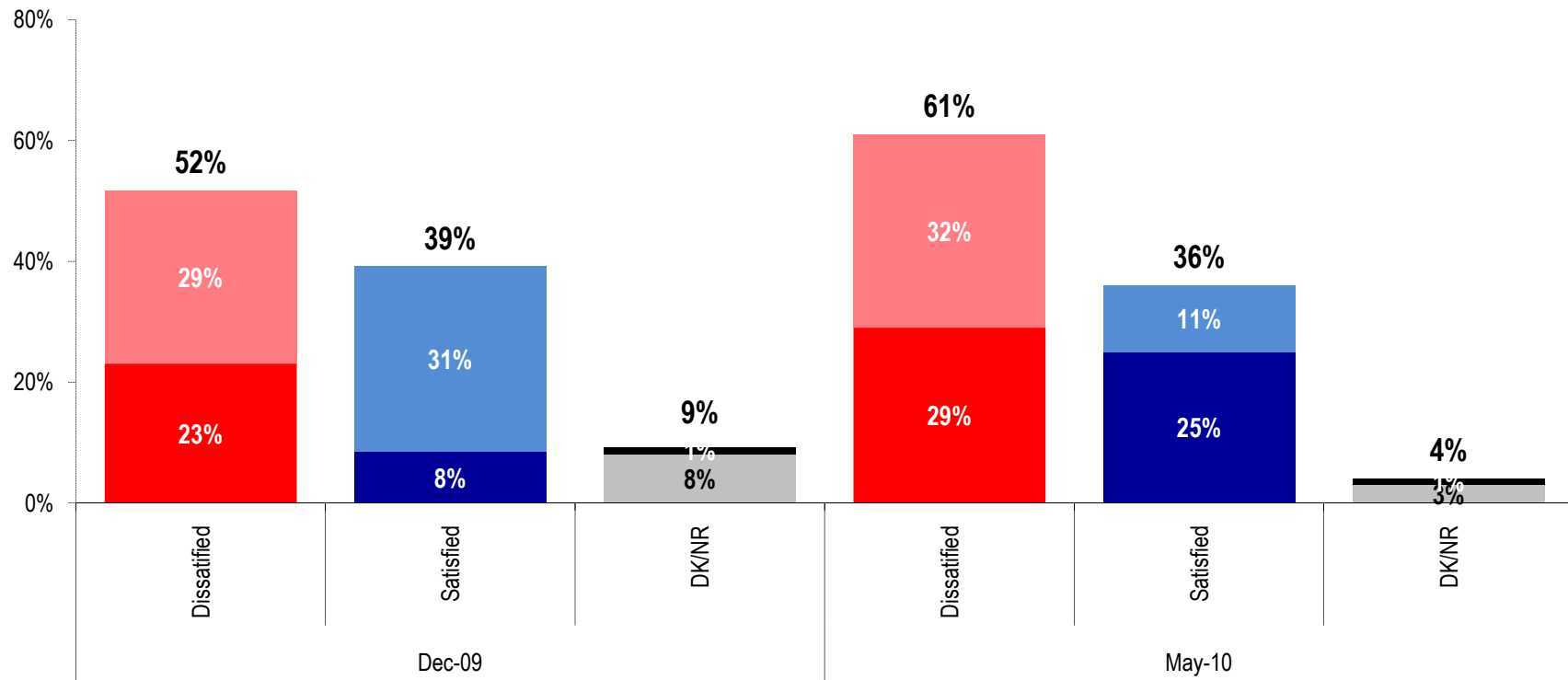

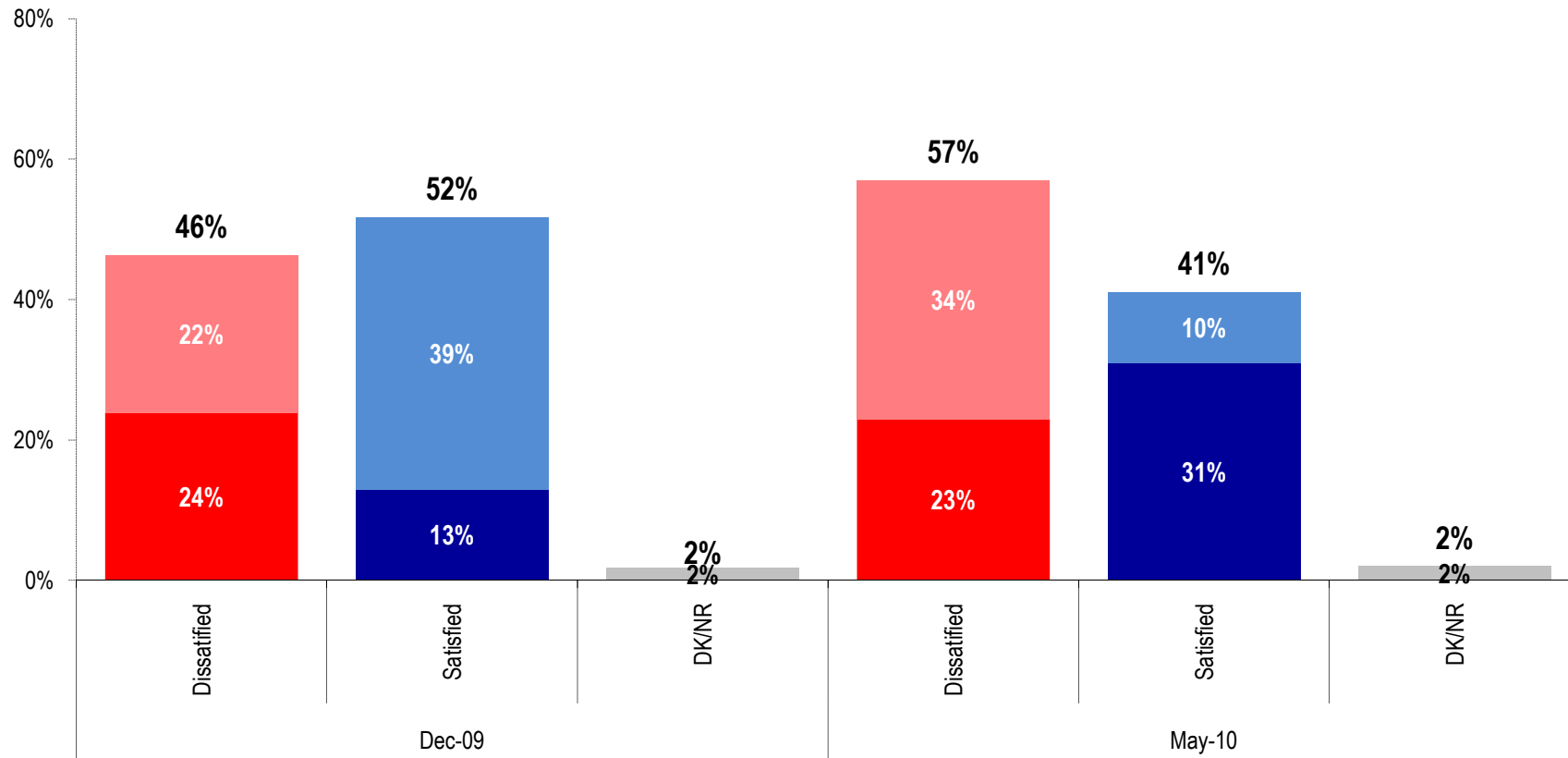

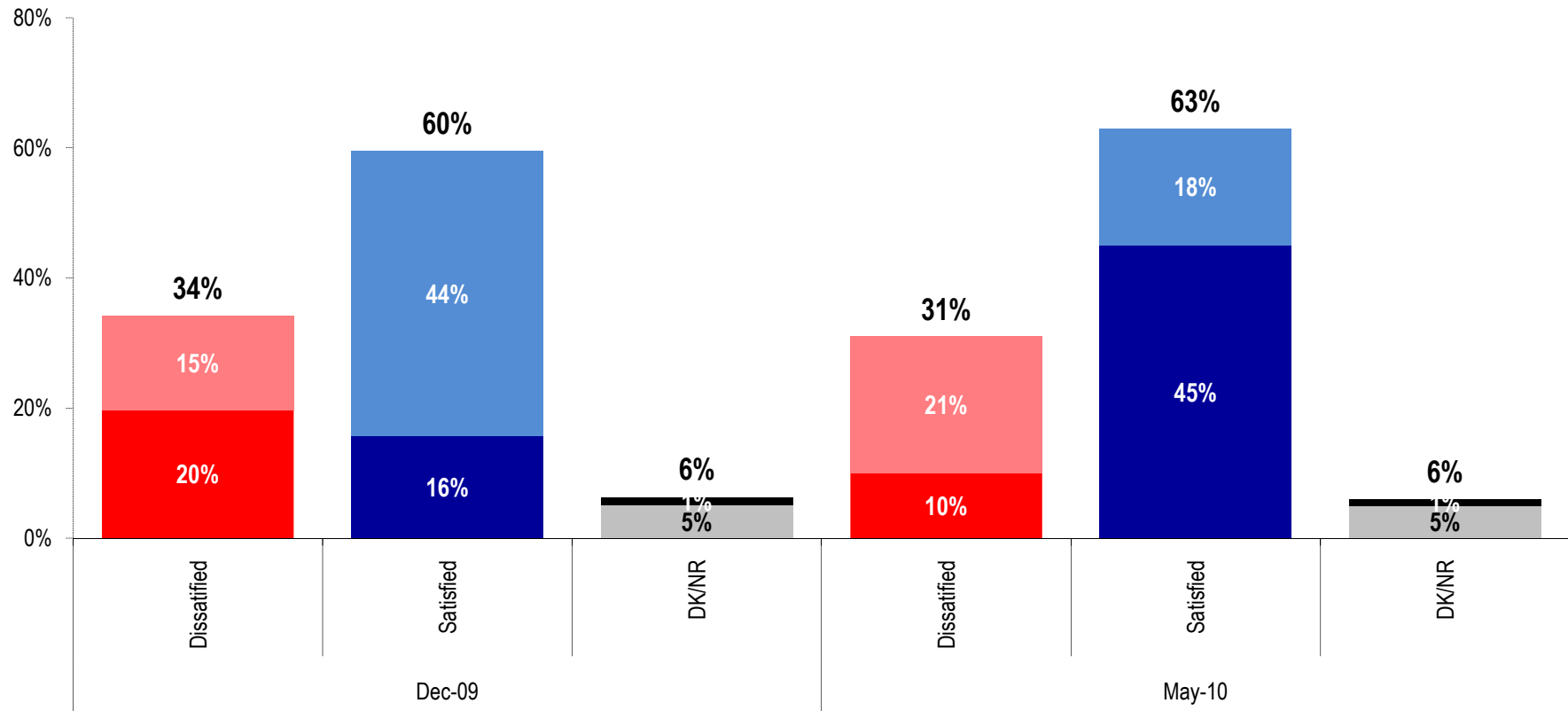

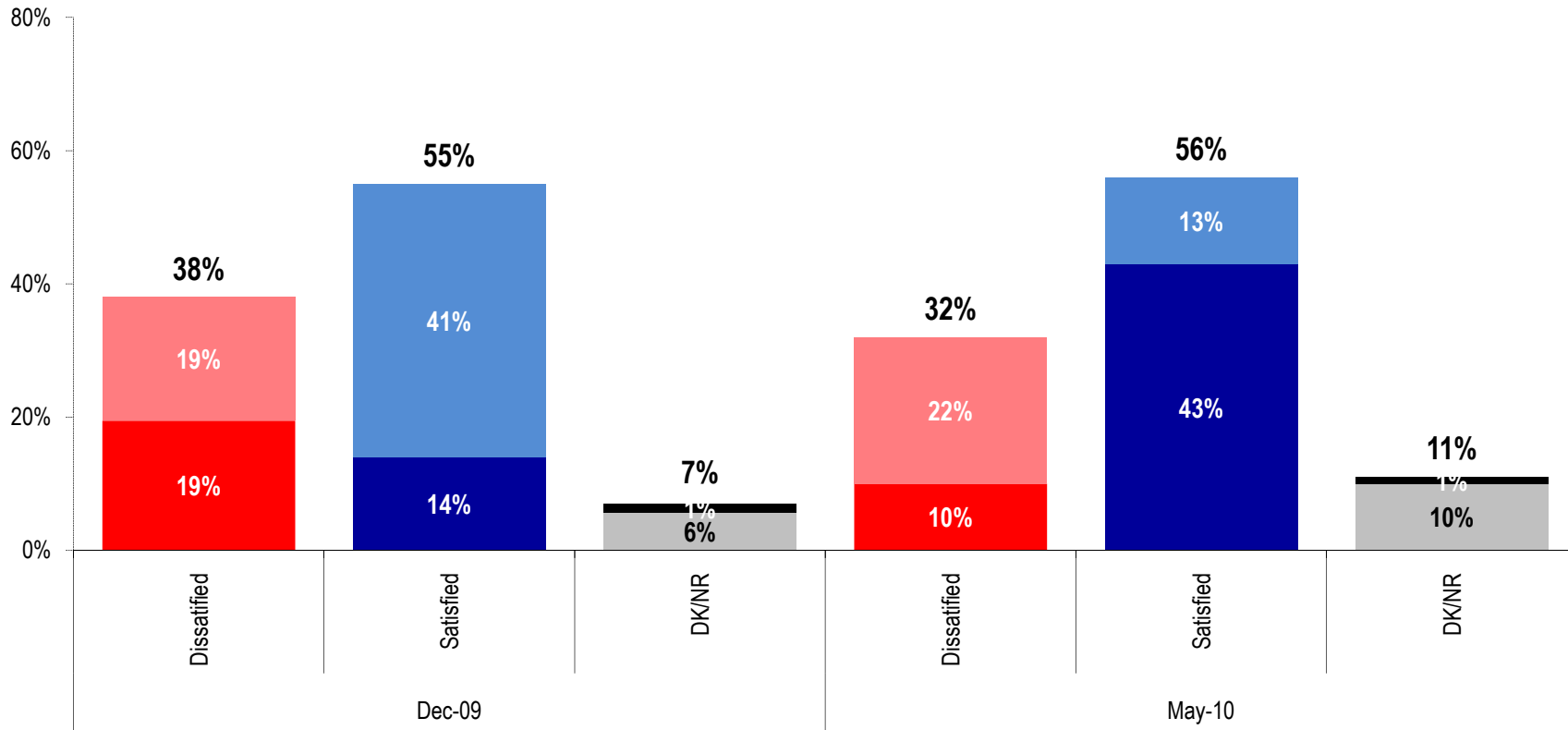

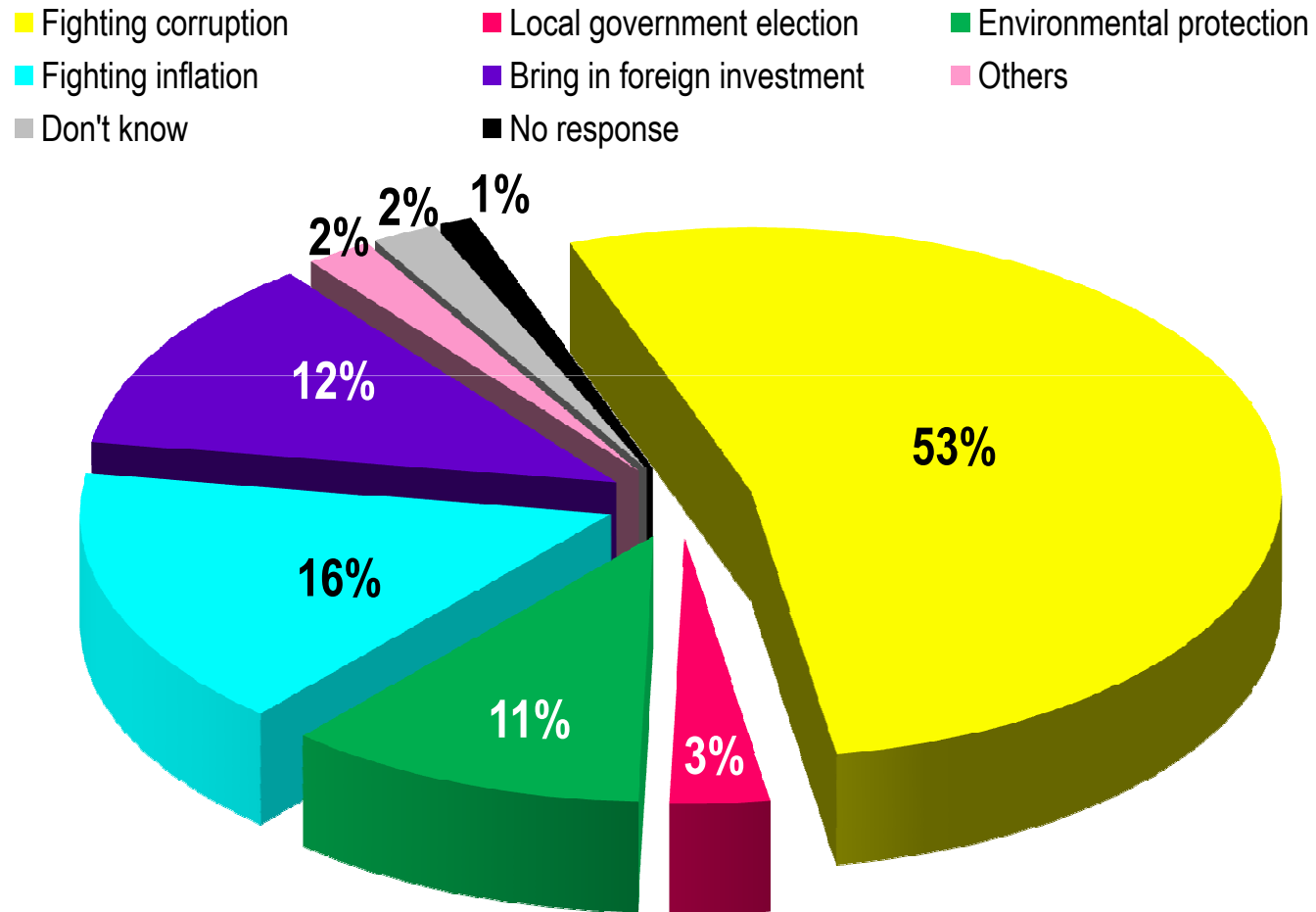

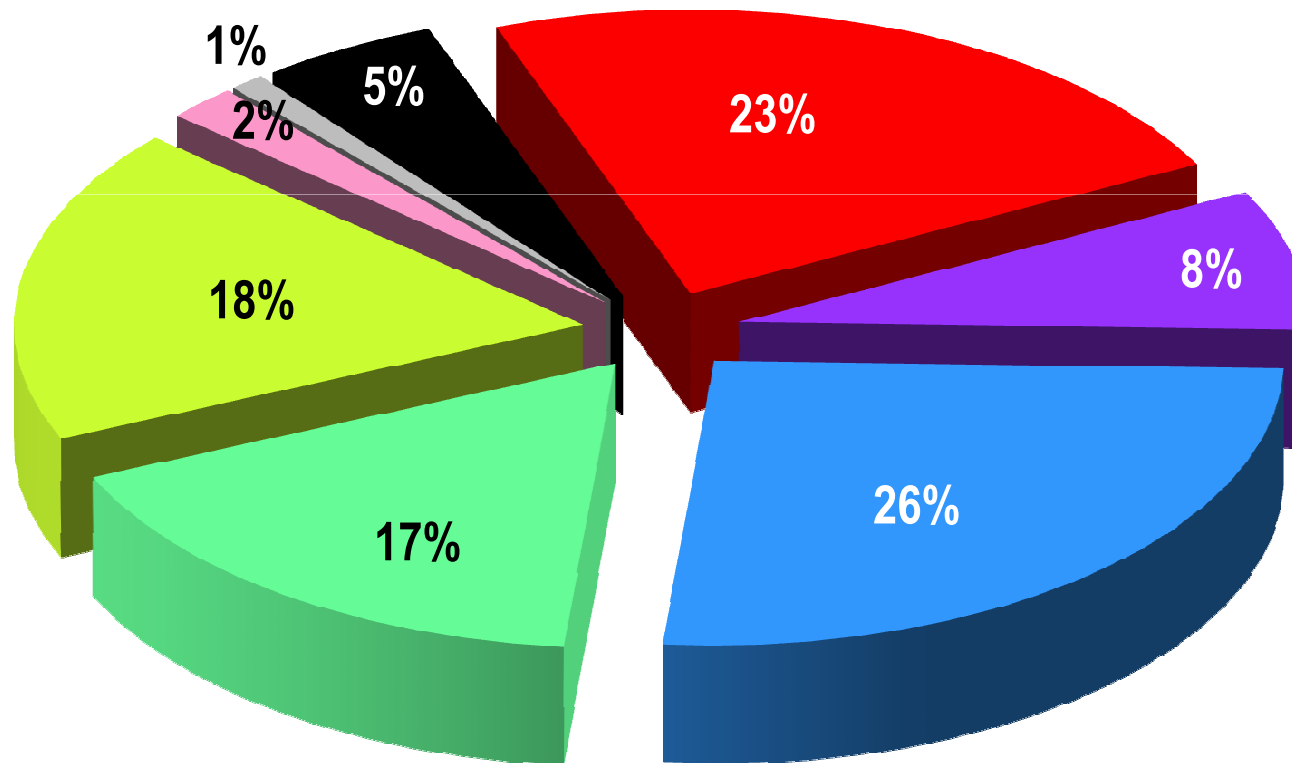

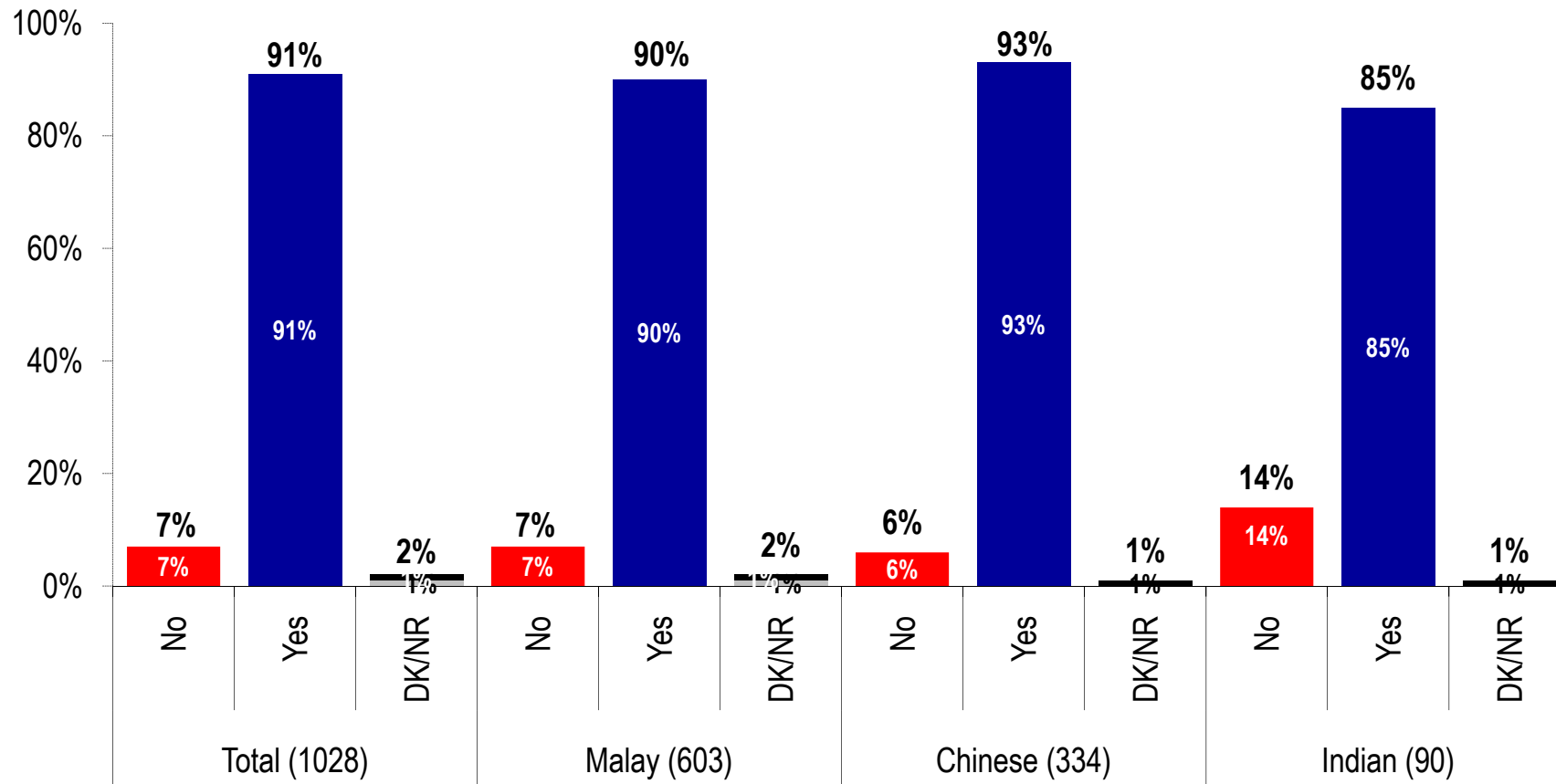

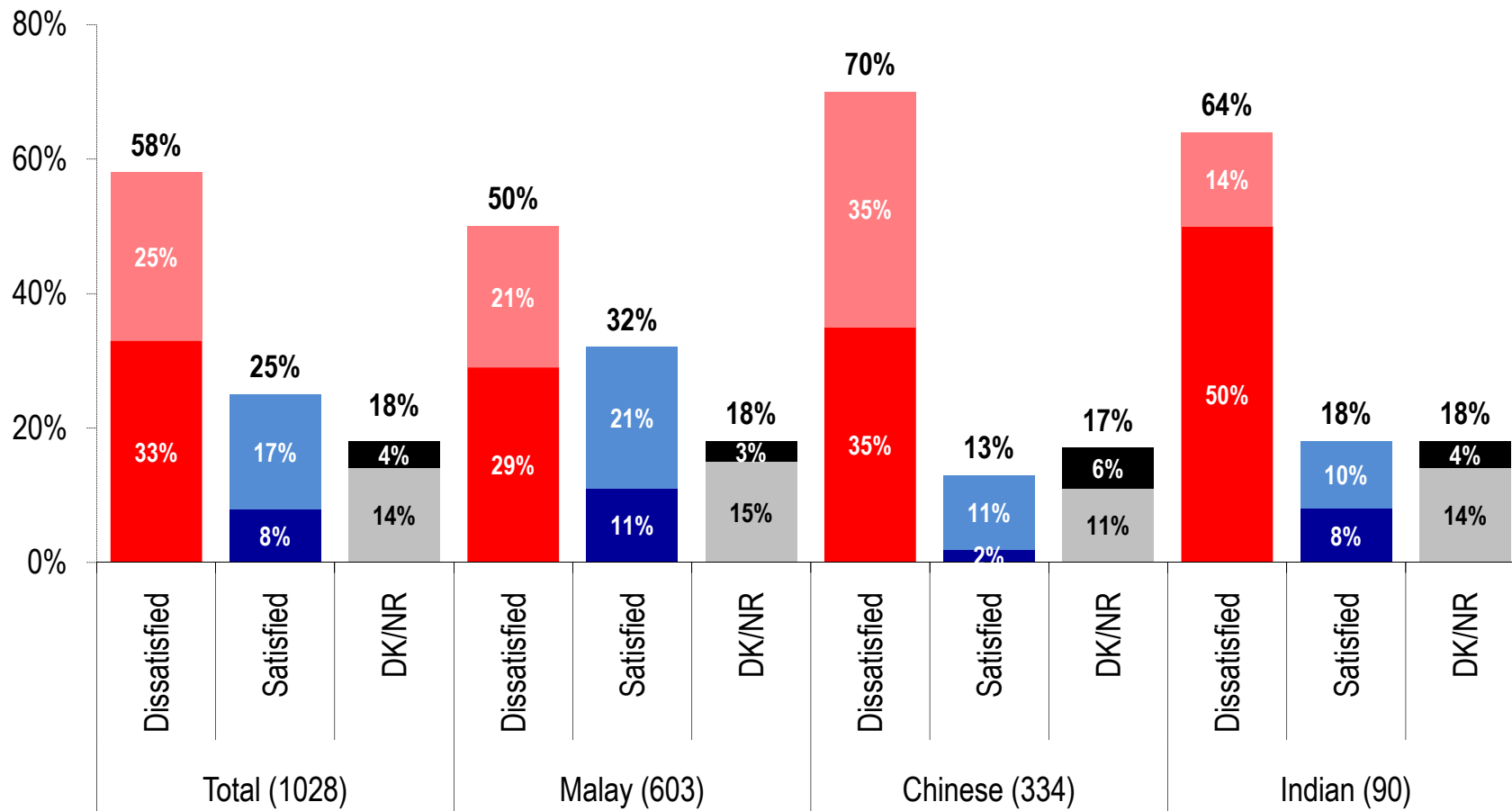


Perception on Aminulrasyid's Case

Are you aware or not aware of the Aminulrasyid's case where a 15 year old boy was shot by the police in Shah Alam?

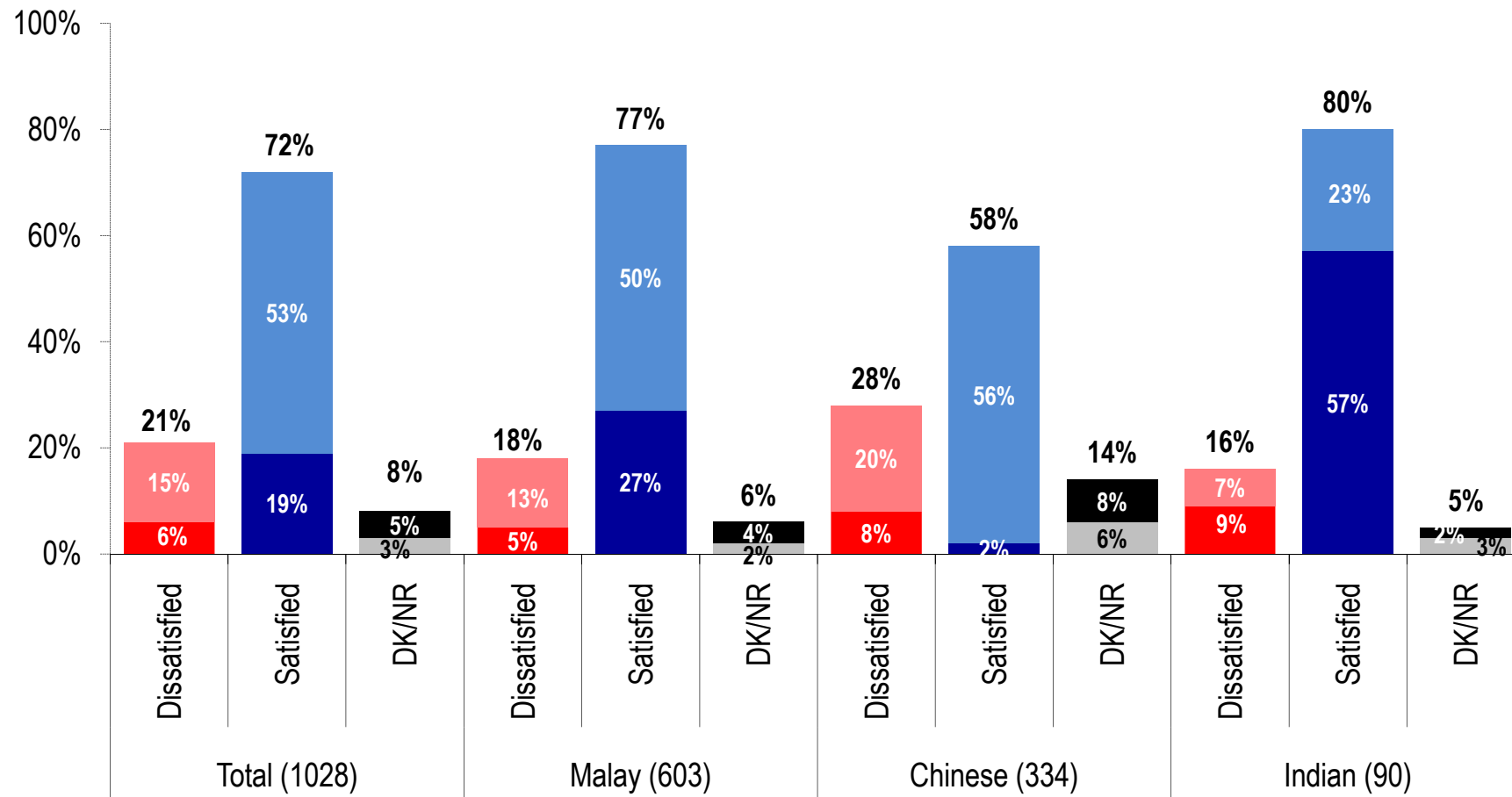


How satisfied or dissatisfied are you with the way that the police is handling the Aminulrasyid's case?

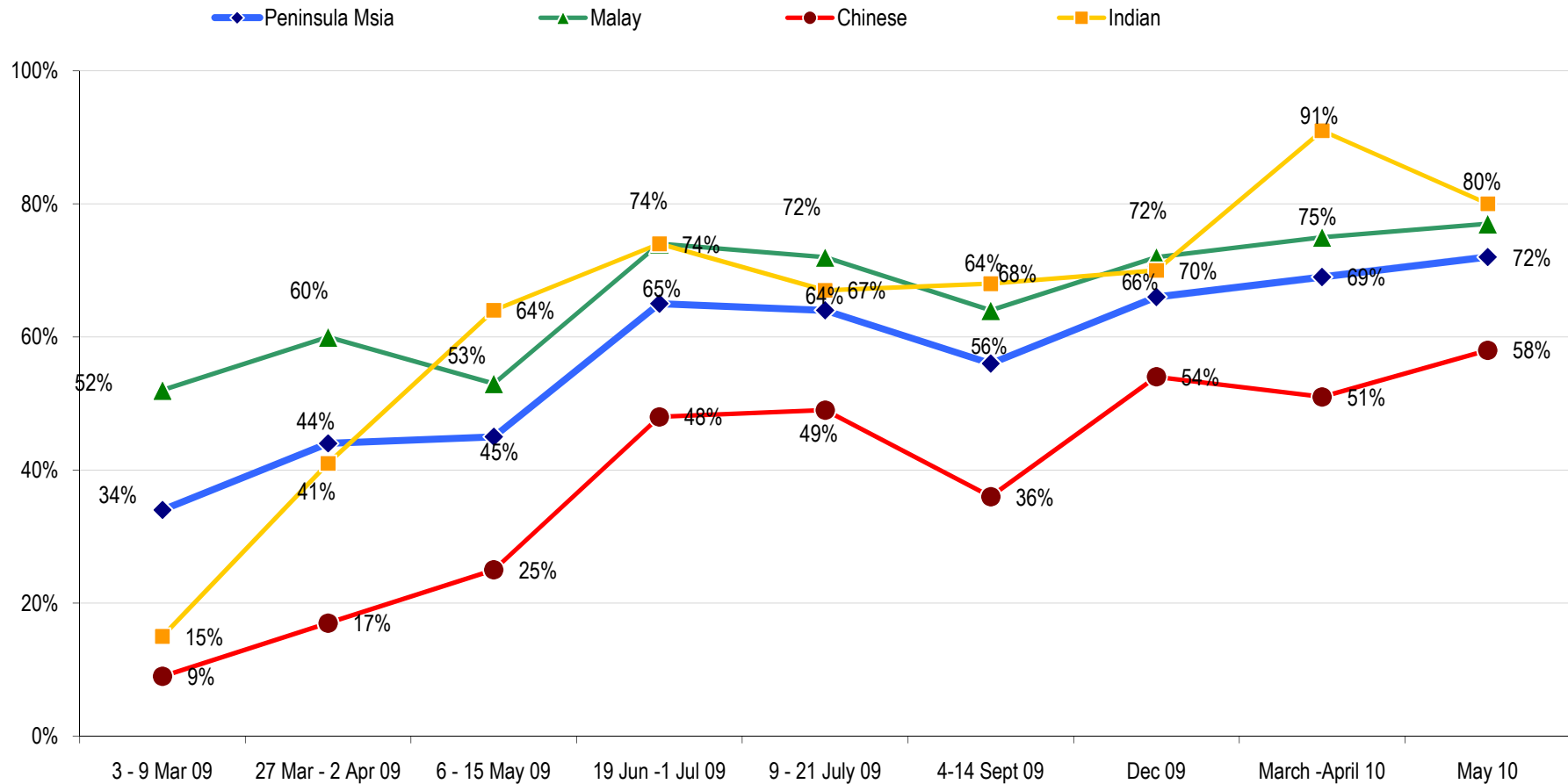


Prime Minister's Approval Rating

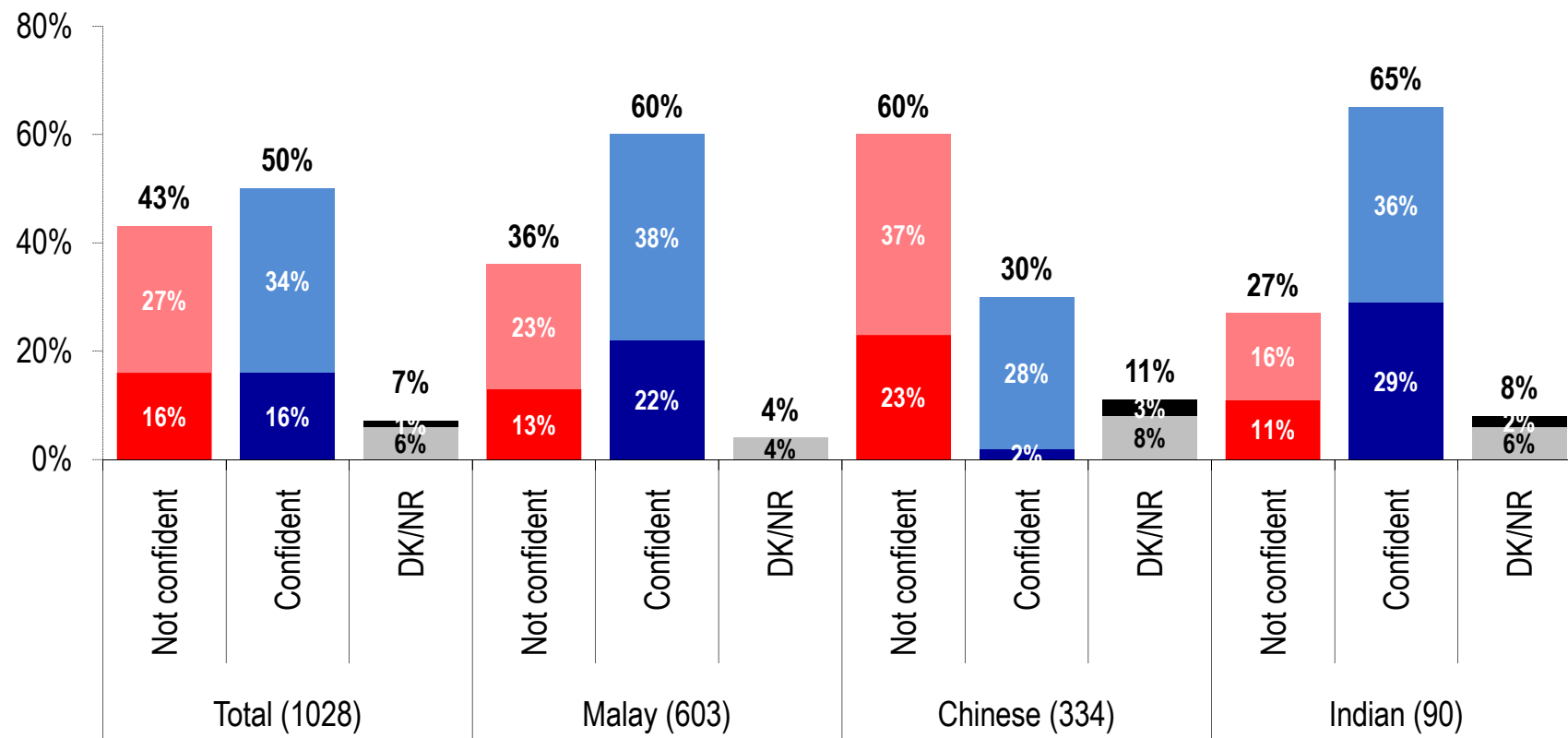
How satisfied or dissatisfied are you with the performance of Najib Tun Razak as Prime Minister?



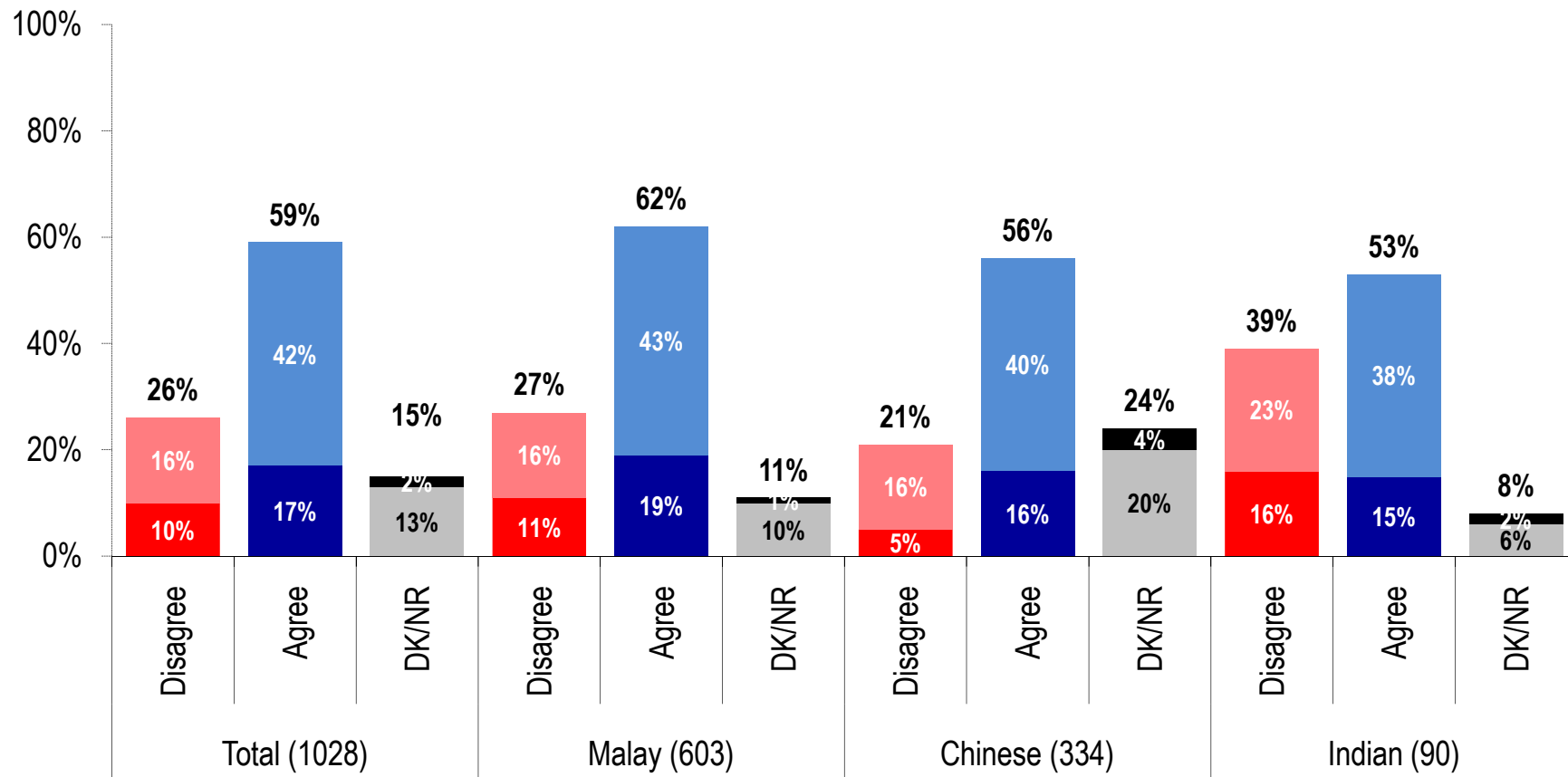
